

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(A6 LOUGHBOROUGH ROAD, BIRSTALL)
(IMPOSITION OF 24 HOUR CLEARWAY) ORDER 2010

The Leicestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any motor vehicle to stop or wait on the sides of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Leicestershire County Council (A6 Loughborough Road, Birstall) (Imposition of 24 Hour Clearway) Order 2010 and shall come into force on the Eighteenth day of January 2010.
3. The plan annexed to this Order and marked drawing number TM/1600/1/2005 is for identification purposes only.

SCHEDULE

IMPOSITION OF 24 HOUR CLEARWAY

A6 (Main Carriageway Only)

From a point level with the northern boundary of No. 751 Loughborough Road in a generally northern direction to a point approximately 11 metres south east from the boundary between No.s 280 and 282 Leicester Road (A6) Loughborough for a distance of approximately 11 kilometres.
