<u>THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (LOUGHBOROUGH EASTERN GATEWAY (AREA 5), DISTRICT OF CHARNWOOD) ORDER NO. 2 2012

The Leicestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) 4(2) 32 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into force on the Eighteenth day of June 2012 and may be cited as "The Leicestershire County Council (Loughborough Eastern Gateway (Area 5), District of Charnwood) Order No. 2 2012".
- 2. The exemptions contained in this Order as set out in column 1 of Schedule 1 shall hereafter be referred to by reference to the code letters given in column 2 of Schedule 1.
- 3. (1) In this Order -

"ambulance" means any motor vehicle used in the service of any National Health Service Trust or Foundation or other body (other than a private medical care provider) which is recognized as providing a public ambulance service;

"authorised cab rank" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"authorised parking place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act;

"bus" means any Public Service Vehicle or bus operating a local stage carriage service as defined in the Transport Act 1985;

"bus stop area" means any area of carriageway on the sides of roads specified in this Order which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with either diagram 1025.2 or diagram 1025.3 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"C.E.O." means a duly authorised Civil Enforcement Officer;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(Amendment) Regulations 1991; or the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000 and the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons)(England) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons)(England and Wales)(Amendment) Regulations 1991;

"disabled persons designated parking bay" means the part of the carriageway or side of road marked in accordance with Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 by the marking shown in diagram 1028.3 (or permitted variant thereof) and with a white broken line bounding the words "DISABLED" marked outside the bay;

"doctors' permit holders" means a vehicle which displays a valid permit issued to a Doctor for use in a specified location;

"footway parking area" means an area of the footway specifically designated for the purpose of waiting;

"hackney carriage" has the same meaning as in section 38(1) of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971;

"Loading" and "Unloading" means the collection or delivery of goods (parcels, stock and other items of that nature) to or from a vehicle where the goods cannot be reasonably collected or delivered except by the use of that vehicle in a particular length of road. "market day" means any day of the week approved and authorised under a market charter for the holding of a market or such other bona fide licensed market;

"Market trader" means any person duly authorised an appropriate body to trade from an authorised market stall or stand or location as from time to time may be specified by the appropriate body for the purposes of his or her trading; "motor vehicle" means any vehicle as defined by the Construction and Use Regulations 1986 (as amended) which is mechanically propelled except where otherwise provided;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No.4631:1970) but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, or a blue badge under the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000;

"permitted parking place" means any part of a road hereby authorised by the Council for use as a parking place being a place where vehicles may wait and is indicated as such by signs and road markings;

"permit" means a written warrant issued by or on behalf of Leicestershire County Council allowing the holder to wait in a specified location;

"permit holder" means a vehicle which displays a valid permit;

"residents' parking permit holder / residents' permit holder" means a vehicle which displays a valid permit issued to a resident of the specified location;

"road / roads" means the carriageway the footway and any verges being the full width of the highway extent from one boundary to another;

"school entrance" means any area of carriageway on the side of the road specified in Schedule 12 of this Order where vehicles are not permitted to stop and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1027.1 of the 2002 Regulations; "vehicle" means any Motor Vehicle as defined in this Order and any other vehicle (capable of the carriage of persons or goods) except cycles unless otherwise provided;

"4.00 p.m. to 10.00 a.m. the following morning" wherever referred to in this Order means that period of time commencing at 4.00 p.m. in the afternoon of any day and terminating at 10.00 a.m. on the morning of the next day; "The Act" means The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, where in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991 and the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000
 - the Badge is displayed on the vehicle's dashboard or fascia panel with the front of the Badge facing forward with the details thereon clearly visible from an external position, or
 - (ii) where the vehicle has no dashboard or fascia panel or windscreen where the Badge may be exhibited or displayed it shall be exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle and

in either case a parking disc is exhibited in the relevant position prescribed in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991 or the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000.

(3) For the purposes of this Order and where any article permits, it shall not be unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the sides of roads referred to in the specific article, for a period not exceeding 3 hours unless otherwise stated (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour, unless otherwise stated, from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road on the same day) provided that no such vehicle shall wait in any length of road where there is for the time being a prohibition of loading and unloading.

4. The Leicestershire County Council (Various Roads, Loughborough (Area 5), District of Charnwood) Consolidation and Amendment Order 2009" is hereby revoked in respect of those lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

- 5.1 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., or in accordance with the exemption provisions, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day, in the restricted zone specified in Schedule 3 Part 1 to this Order.
- 5.2 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, in the permitted parking place specified in Schedule 3 Part 2 to this Order:-

(a) For a period longer that 1 hour; or

(b) If a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting by that vehicle in the same permitted parking place;

5.3 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, in the permitted parking place specified in Schedule 3 Part 3 to this Order, except for resident's parking permit holders:-

(a) For a period longer than 1 hour, or

(b) If a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same permitted parking place;

5.4 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, in the permitted parking place specified in Schedule 3 Part 4 to this Order:-

(a) For a period longer than 2 hours, or

(b) If a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same permitted parking place;

5.5 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, in the permitted partial footway parking place specified in Schedule 3 Part 5 to this Order, except for resident's parking permit holders:-

(a) For a period longer than 1 hour, or

(b) If a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same permitted parking place;

- 5.6 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, on the sides of roads specified in Schedule 3 Part 6 to this Order, except for any ambulance.
- 5.7 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the permitted parking place specified in Schedule 3 Part 7 to this Order, except for disabled persons vehicle.
- 5.8 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., or in accordance with the exemption provisions, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 Part 8 to this Order.
- 5.9 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., or in accordance with the exemption provisions, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day, on the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 Part 9 to this Order.
- 5.10 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., or in accordance with the

exemption provisions, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 Part 10 to this Order.

5.11 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, in the permitted parking place specified in Schedule 3 Part 11 to this Order:-

(a) For a period longer than 2 hour, or

(b) If a period of less than 2 hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same permitted parking place;

- 5.12 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., or in accordance with the exemption provisions, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, on the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 Part 12 to this Order.
- 5.13 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., or in accordance with the exemption provisions, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, on the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 Part 13 to this Order.
- 5.14 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, a community support officer, a parking attendant or a C.E.O., or in accordance with the exemption provisions, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along that length of road, cause or permit any vehicle to wait any time on any day or cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle in the pedestrian zone except for access specified in Schedule 3 Part 14 to this Order.
- 6. The written restriction applicable to those lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 4 are hereby revoked and re-enacted as amended in Schedule 5. Such amendments shall have no

- practical effect on the restrictions as set out on those lengths of roads and shall not affect the use of such roads by members of the public.
- 7. Except where otherwise stated, a reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 8. The plans annexed to this Order and marked drawing numbers D124377/TRO2/01 and TM2902(3)/1/2011 are for identification purposes only.

BURDER STREET, LOUGHBOROUGH

(i) The east side the approach road to Midland Railway Station from its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 52 metres.

(iii) The north-east side from its junction with Meadow Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

(vi) The south-west side from a point 7 metres north-west of its junction with Glebe Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 15 metres south-east of that junction.

CARTWRIGHT STREET, LOUGHBOROUGH

Both sides from its junction with Meadow Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 14 metres.

CLARENCE STREET, LOUGHBOROUGH

(i) The north side from its junction with Meadow Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 13.5 metres.

(ii) The north side from its junction with Nottingham Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 4 metres.

(iii) The south side from its junction with Meadow Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 37 metres.

(iv) The south side from a point opposite the eastern boundary of No. 19 Clarence Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 56 metres.

DUKE STREET, LOUGHBOROUGH

Both sides from its junction with Clarence Street in a southerly direction for its entire length.

GLEBE STREET, LOUGHBOROUGH

(i) The east side from a point 48 metres south of its junction with Clarence Street in a northerly direction to its junction with Clarence Street.

(ii) The east side from its junction with Nottingham Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 39 metres.

(iii) The west side from a point 42 metres south of its junction with Toothill Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Toothill Road.

(iv) The west side from its junction with Nottingham Road in a northerly direction to a point 42 metres south of its junction with Toothill Road.

NOTTINGHAM ROAD, LOUGHBOROUGH

(i) The north side from its junction with Meadow Lane to its junction with Barrack Row.

(ii) The south side from its junction with The Coneries in a westerly direction for a distance of 21 metres.

(iii) The south side from its junction with Sparrow Hill in an easterly direction for a distance of 16 metres.

RATCLIFFE ROAD, LOUGHBOROUGH

(i) Both sides from a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with Glebe Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 27.5 metres south-east of its junction with Glebe Street.

(ii) Both sides from its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 45.5 metres.

(iii) Both sides from its junction with Meadow Lane in a south-easterly direction to a point opposite the boundary of Nos. 15 and 17 Ratcliffe Road.

(iv) The north-east side from a point 45.5 metres north-west of its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 3.5 metres.

(v) The south side from a point 45 metres west of its junction with Nottingham Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 51 metres.

SPARROW HILL, LOUGHBOROUGH

(i) Both sides from its junction with Baxter Gate to its junction with Church Gate.

(ii) The south-east side from its junction with Nottingham Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 26 metres.

(iii) The south-east side from a point opposite the southern boundary of 12 Sparrow Hill in a northerly direction for a distance of 13.5 metres.

NO WAITING 7.00 AM – 7.00 PM

RATCLIFFE ROAD, LOUGHBOROUGH

(i) The north-east side from a point 27 metres south-east of its junction with Glebe Street to a point 50 metres north-west of its junction with Nottingham Road.
