## The City Council of Liverpool (Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Order 2009) (Variation No.46) Order, 2017

The City Council of Liverpool in exercise of its powers under Sections 1-4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45-53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

## 1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 2017 and may be cited as:
- The City Council of Liverpool (Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Order 2009) (Variation No.46) Order, 2017.

## 2. Interpretation

- (1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2009 shall have the same respective meaning.
- (2) In this Order the expression "Order of 2009" means The City Council of Liverpool Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone Order, 2009 as amended.

## <u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas Of Highways Designated As Residents</u> <u>Parking Places</u>

3. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 1** the new residents parking place was included as specified in the **Schedule** to this Order.
