The City Council of Liverpool (Helsby Street, Highgate Street, Mason Street & Paddington) (One-Way Traffic) Order, 2019

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, & 2 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

Section 1: Commencement, Citation & General Articles

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 25 day of November 2019 and may be cited as: The City Council of Liverpool (Helsby Street, Highgate Street, Mason Street & Paddington) (One-Way Traffic) Order 2019.
- 2. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

Section 2: One-Way Traffic

4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on: - (a) **Helsby Street**, in a direction other than **easterly**; (b) **Highgate Street**, from its junction with Paddington to its junction with Helsby Street, in a direction other than **northerly**; (c) **Mason Street**, from its junction with Helsby Street to its junction with Paddington, in a direction other than **southerly**; & (d) **Paddington (eastern section)**, from its junction with Mason Street to its junction with Highgate Street, in a direction other than **westerly**.

Section 3: Contravention Of The Order

5. Any person who contravenes **Article 4** of this Order, or who uses a vehicle, or causes or permits a vehicle to be used in contravention of **Article 4** of this Order, shall be guilty of an offence.
