(Consolidation) (Order 2006) (Variation N°173) Order, 2019

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "**the Council**") in exercise of its powers under **Sections 1, 2, 4, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 49, 53** and **Part IV** of **Schedule 9** to **The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "**the Act of 1984**") as amended by **The Road Traffic (Parking) Act 1986** (hereinafter referred to as "**the Act of 1986**") and **Section 43** of **Schedule 3** of **The Road Traffic Act 1991** (hereinafter referred to as "**the Act of 1991**") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, the Traffic Commissioner for the North West and the Merseyside Passenger Transport Executive in accordance with **Part III** of **Schedule 9** to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

Commencement, Citation and General Articles

1. This **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order** shall come into operation on the **3** day of **June 2019** and may be cited as: - **The City Council of Liverpool (North – Part 1 Stationary Vehicle Offences) (Consolidation) (Order 2006) (Experimental Variation N°173) Order, 2019.**
2. This **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order** shall remain in force for a **maximum period** of up to **eighteen months** expiring on the **30 November 2020.**
3. As provided by **Section 10(2) (Supplementary Provisions As To Experimental Traffic Orders)** of the Act of 1984 this **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order** includes the provision to empower the **Divisional Manager (Highways & Transportation)** of the Council, or a person authorised by the **Divisional Manager**, to modify or suspend the operation of this **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order** or any provision of it if it appears to him essential: - (a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic; (b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities; or (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order** runs. The power conferred by such this provision shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate **Chief Officer of Police** and giving such public notice as the **Secretary of State** may direct.
4. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2006 shall have the same respective meaning.
5. In this **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order** the expression "**Order of 2006**" means **The City Council Of Liverpool (North – Part 1 Stationary Vehicle Offences) (Consolidation) Order, 2006**, as amended.
6. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order** to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order.**

Variation Of The Order Of 2006 As Respects Areas Of Highway Designated As Residents Parking Places

7. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though for certain roads within **Schedule 3** the **existing permitted days & hours specified in Column 3 of Schedule 1** to this Order were substituted for the **new permitted days & hours specified in Column 3 of Schedule 2** to this Order.

NOTE: The extent of the affected residents parking places and permitted parking area specified in **Columns 1 & 2** of this schedule remain unchanged.

Variation Of The Order Of 2006 As Respects Roads And Parts Of Roads In Which Waiting Is Prohibited At Certain Times

8. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though for certain roads within **Schedule 16** the **existing days and times of prohibition specified in Column 3 of Schedule 3** to this Order were substituted for the **new days and times of prohibition specified in Column 3 of Schedule 4** to this Order.

NOTE: The extent of the affected prohibition of waiting at certain times specified in **Columns 1 & 2** of this schedule remain unchanged.

Variation Of The Order Of 2006 As Respects Areas Of Highway Designated As Hackney Carriage Clearways (For Information Only)

9. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though for certain roads within **Schedule 19** the **existing operating hours specified in Column 2 of Schedule 5** were substituted for the **new operating hours specified in Column 2 of Schedule 6** to this Order.

NOTE: The extent of the affected hackney carriage clearways (for information only) specified in **Columns 1, 3 & 4** of this schedule remain unchanged.
