The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Experimental Variation No106) Order, 2020

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 & 10(2) of Schedule 9 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Experimental Traffic Regulation Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

- (1) This Experimental Traffic Regulation Order shall come into operation on the 30 day of November 2020 and may be cited as: The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Experimental Variation №106) Order, 2020.
- (2) This Experimental Traffic Regulation Order shall remain in force for a maximum period of up to eighteen months expiring on the 30 day of May 2022.
- (3) As provided by Section 10(2) (Supplementary Provisions As To Experimental Traffic Orders) of the Act of 1984 this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order includes the provision to empower the Divisional Manager (Highways & Transportation) of the Council, or a person authorised by the Divisional Manager, to modify or suspend the operation of this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order or any provision of it if it appears to him essential: (a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic; (b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities; or (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order runs. The power conferred by such this provision shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct.

2. Interpretation

- (1) In this **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order** except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2009 shall have the same respective meaning.
- (2) Furthermore, in this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order the expression "Order of 2009" means The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) Order 2009, as amended.

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas Of Highways Designated As Parking Places For Vehicles For Loading And Unloading</u>

- 3. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Schedule 3: -
- (a) The existing inner zone roads numbered **154A**, **154C** & **154D** were omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 1** to this Order.
- (b) The new inner zone roads numbered 154C & 154D were included as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas Of Highways Designated As Disabled Persons'</u> Parking Places

- 4. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Schedule 5: -
- (a) The existing inner zone road numbered **154** was omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 3** to this Order.
- (b) The new inner zone road numbered **154** was included as specified in **Schedule 4** to this Order.

Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Hackney Carriage Clearways

- 5. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Schedule 33: -
- (a) The existing inner zone roads numbered **154A** & **154B** were omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 5** to this Order.
- (b) The new inner zone road numbered 154A, 154B & 154C was included as specified in Schedule 6 to this Order.
