The City Council of Liverpool (Bus Corridor "E") (Childwall Road, Childwall Valley Road, High Street, Picton Road and Wavertree Road) (Revocation, Reserved Bus Lane, Prohibition of Waiting, Prohibition of Loading and Unloading and Bus Stop Clear Way) Order, 2005

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 2005 and may be cited as: The City Council of Liverpool (Bus Corridor "E") (Childwall Road, Childwall Valley Road, High Street, Picton Road and Wavertree Road) (Revocation, Reserved Bus Lane, Prohibition of Waiting, Prohibition of Loading and Unloading and Bus Stop Clear Way) Order, 2005.
- 2. (1) In this Order:-

"hackney carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 38(1) of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971;

"loading and unloading" means the transference from (or to) a vehicle to (or from) premises adjacent to where the vehicle is parked of heavy or unmanageable Goods that are not designed to be carried by hand other than over a very short distance.

"pedal cycle" means a pedal bicycle or pedal tricycle, not being in either case a motor vehicle;

"penalty charge" and "reduced penalty charge" means a charge set by the City of Liverpool under the provisions of Section 74 of The Road Traffic Act 1991 in accordance with guidance given by the Secretary of State for Transport which is to be paid in the manner described in the penalty charge notice within 28 days of the date of the notice or 14 days of the date of the notice in the case of a reduced penalty charge.

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued by a parking attendant pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 of The Road Traffic Act 1991.

"public service vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a tram car) which - (a) being a vehicle adapted to carry more than eight passengers, is being used for carrying passengers for hire or reward; or (b) being a vehicle not so adapted, is being used for carrying passengers for hire or reward at separate fares in the course of a business of carrying passengers;

- 2. (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. The Orders specified in Column One of Schedule One to this Order are hereby revoked to the extent specified on Column Two of the said schedule.
- 4. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle other than a public service vehicle, pedal cycle, hackney carriage, a vehicle being used by the Police, Ambulance, Fire Service or Statutory Services, Post Office and Local Authority in pursuance with their essential duties to enter or proceed in the reserved bus lane, other than for the purposes of crossing it, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Column One of Schedule Two to this Order to the extent specified in Column Two of the said schedule.
- 5. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle other than a public service vehicle, pedal cycle, hackney carriage, a vehicle being used by the Police, Ambulance, Fire Service or Statutory Services, Post Office and Local Authority in pursuance with their essential duties to enter or proceed in the reserved bus lane, other than for the purposes of crossing it, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. on Mondays to


Order to the extent specified in Column Two of the said schedule.

- 6. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads specified in **Column One** of **Schedule Four** to this Order to the extent specified in **Column Two** of the said schedule.
- 7. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the sides of lengths of roads specified in Column One of Schedule Five to this Order to the extent specified in Column Two of the said schedule.
- 8. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the side of length of road specified in Column One of Schedule Six to this Order to the extent specified in Column Two of the said schedule.
- 9. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle allowing passengers to board or alight, to wait for the purposes of loading and unloading between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between the hours 4.00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads specified in Column One of Schedule Seven to this Order to the extent specified in Column Two of the said schedule.
- 10. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle allowing passengers board or alight, to wait for the purposes of loading and unloading between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the side of length of road specified in Column One of Schedule Eight to this Order to the extent specified in Column Two of the said schedule.
- 11. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle allowing passengers to board or alight, to wait for the purposes of loading and unloading between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Column One of Schedule Nine to this Order to the extent specified in Column Two of the said schedule.
- 12. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle allowing passengers to board or alight, to wait for the purposes of loading and unloading between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Column One of Schedule Ten to this Order to the extent specified in Column Two of the said schedule.
- 13. If a vehicle is left at any time in contravention of a provision of this Order a penalty charge shall be payable.
- In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice moving the information required by Section 66 of The Road Traffic Act 1991 may then be issued by a parking attendant in accordance with the requirements of Section 66 of that Act.
- 15. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
