The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as “**the Council**”) in exercise of its powers under **Sections 1, 2, 4, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as “**the Act of 1984**”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the **Chief Officer of Police, the Traffic Commissioner for the North West and the Merseyside Passenger Transport Executive** in accordance with **Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984**, hereby makes the following Order:-

Section One - Commencement, Citation, Interpretations and General Articles

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 15th day of April 2009 and may be cited as: - **The City Council Of Liverpool (North – Part 2 Moving Vehicle Offences) (Consolidation) (Order 2006) (Variation N°26) Order 2009.**
2. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2006 shall have the same respective meaning.
3. 4. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
5. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

Section Two

Variation Of Order Of 2006 As Respects SECTION ONE (Commencement, Citation, Interpretations And General Articles)

6. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though in **Article 2 (Interpretations)**: -

(a) The existing interpretation of “**parking attendant**” was substituted by the new interpretation of “**civil enforcement officer**” as specified below in this Order: -

“**civil enforcement officer**” means a person authorized by or on behalf of the City of Liverpool under **Section 76 of The Traffic Management Act 2004** to supervise and enforce the restrictions imposed by Traffic Regulation Orders made by the Council.

(b) The new interpretation of “**licensed private hire vehicle**” was included as specified below in this Order: -

“**licensed private hire vehicle**” has the same meaning as in **Section 80(1) of The Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1976**.

Section Three

Variation Of Order Of 2006 As Respects SECTION THREE (Moving Vehicle Restrictions)

7. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though the existing **Article 17 (Reserved Bus Lanes)** was substituted by the new **Article 17 (Reserved Bus Lanes)** as specified below in this Order: -

Reserved Bus Lanes

17. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle other than a public service vehicle, coach, pedal cycle, hackney carriage, licensed private hire vehicle, a vehicle being used by the Police, Ambulance, Fire Service or Statutory Services, Postal Operator and Local Authority in pursuance with their essential duties to enter, proceed or wait in the reserved bus lane specified in Column One of Schedule 12 to this Order, to the extent specified in Column Two of the said Schedule, other than for the purposes of crossing it, during the hours and on the days of operation specified in Column Three of the said Schedule.

Section Four

Variation Of Order Of 2006 As Respects Reserved Bus Lanes

8. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though in Schedule 12 there were included the new reserved bus lanes on **County Road (east and west sides), East Prescot Road (south side), Kensington (north and south sides), Longmoor Lane (east side), Prescot Road (south side), Rice Lane (west side) and Warbreck Moor (east side)** as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
