The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

## Section One - Commencement, Citation, Interpretations and General Articles

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of January 2011 and may be cited as: -

(Revocation, Prohibition of "U"- Turn, Prohibition of Waiting, Prohibition of Loading and Unloading, Parking Places For Loading / Unloading, Residents Parking Places,
Disabled Persons Parking Places and Reserved Bus Lane) (Order, 2006)
(Amendment) Order, 2011

2. (1) In this Order, save as otherwise defined within this Order, each and every expression shall have the meaning assigned to it by **The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002**: -

"The Order of 2006" means The City Council of Liverpool (Woolton Road, Horrocks Avenue, Holly Farm Road And Liverpool South Parkway Access Road Area) (Revocation, Prohibition of "U"- Turn, Prohibition of Waiting, Prohibition of Loading and Unloading, Parking Places For Loading / Unloading, Residents Parking Places, Disabled Persons Parking Places and Reserved Bus Lane) Order, 2006.

- 3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order.
- 4. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

## Section Two – The Variation Of The Order Of 2006

- 4. The **Order of 2006** is hereby varied in so far as it relates to: -
- (a) The omission from **Schedule One** (**Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time**) of the existing twenty-four hour no-waiting restriction on **Woolton Road** (**northeast bound carriageway**) **northwest side of the road** from a point 46.6 metres southwest of the junction with Stamfordham Drive in a southwesterly direction to a point 32.8 metres northeast of the southwestern property line of N°93 Woolton Road.

(b) The inclusion into Schedule One (Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time) of the new twenty-four no-waiting restrictions, on: - (i) Stamfordham Drive – both sides - from its junction with Mather Avenue for a distance of 15 metres in a north westerly direction; (ii) Woolton Road (northeast bound carriageway) northwest side of the road - from its junction with Mather Avenue in a southwesterly direction to a point 32.8 metres northeast of the southwestern property line of N°93 Woolton Road; and (iii) Mather Avenue (north bound carriageway) – northwest side of the road - from a point 5 metres north of the junction with Stamfordham Drive in a southwesterly direction to its junction with Woolton Road.
