The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.14) Order, 2010

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 25th day of January 2010 and may be cited as The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.14) Order, 2010.

2. Interpretation

- (1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2009 shall have the same respective meaning.
- (2) Furthermore, in this Order the expression "Order of 2009" means The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) Order 2009, as amended by The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.1) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.2) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.3) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.4) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.5) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.6) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.7) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.8) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.10) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.11) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.11) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.11) Order, 2009; and The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.13) Order, 2009;
- (3) In this Order, <u>PART A</u> specifically relates to the changes in traffic management being made within the Liverpool University area of the Outer Controlled Parking Zone (O.C.P.Z.) which consists of the following roads Arrad Street, Brownlow Hill, Cambridge Street, Duckinfield Street, Mount Pleasant, Mulberry Place, Mulberry Street, Myrtle Street, Oxford Street, Paddington and Peach Street.
- (4) In this Order, <u>PART B</u> specifically relates to the changes in traffic management being made within other roads within the <u>Inner Controlled Parking Zone (I.C.P.Z.)</u> and <u>Outer Controlled Parking Zone (O.C.P.Z.)</u> on: Argyle Street (I.C.P.Z.), Canning Place (O.C.P.Z.), Duckinfield Street (O.C.P.Z.), Lime Street (I.C.P.Z.), London Road (O.C.P.Z.), Rodney Street (O.C.P.Z.), Temple Lane (I.C.P.Z.), Temple Street (I.C.P.Z.), Upper Duke Street (O.C.P.Z.), Upper Newington (O.C.P.Z.), Westmorland Drive (O.C.P.Z.) and Whitechapel (I.C.P.Z.)

Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects Arrangement Of Articles

3. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in the Arrangement Of Articles there were substituted the existing Article 48 (Visitors Parking Vouchers) by the new Article 48 (Visitors Parking Permits And Vouchers) as shown below in this Order: -

Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects Interpretations

- 6. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Article 2 (Interpretations) there were included the new interpretation of a Business Parking Place and a Limited Waiting Parking Bay as shown below in this Order:-
- "Business Parking Place" means any area of highway specifically described as such within in Part IV of Schedule 1 to this Order.
- "Limited Waiting Parking Bay" means any area of highway described in Schedule 37 of this Order.
- "Visitors Parking Permit" means a parking permit issued by the Council pursuant to Article 48.
- 7. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Article 2 (Interpretations)** the existing interpretation of a **Parking Place** was substituted by the new interpretation of a **Parking Place** as shown below in this Order: -
- "Parking Place" means each of the areas on a highway described in Schedules 1-13 inclusive and Schedules 25 to 27 inclusive, Schedule 29, Schedules 31-32 and Schedules 35-37 inclusive where vehicles may park subject to the restrictions and provisions set out in this Order.

Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects PART I (DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES)

8. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing **Article 3 (Designation Of Parking Places)** was substituted by the new **Article 3 (Designation Of Parking Places)** as shown below in this Order: -

Designation of Parking Places

3. Each area on a highway in the City of Liverpool which is described in Schedules 1 to 13 inclusive and Schedules 25 to 27 inclusive, Schedule 29, Schedules 31-32 inclusive and Schedule 35-37 inclusive of this Order is designated as a Parking Place subject to the restrictions and provisions set out in this Order.

Variation the Order of 2009 as respects PART II (RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF PARKING PLACES)

9. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing Articles 10-15 (inclusive) (Multi Use Parking Places) and the existing Article 17 (Residents Parking Places) were substituted by the new Articles 10-15

(inclusive) (Multi Use Parking Places) and the new Article 17 (Residents Parking Places) as shown below in this Order: -

Multi Use Parking Places

- 10. No person shall leave a vehicle other than a Passenger Vehicle, Goods Vehicle, Motor Cycle with a side car fitted or Invalid Carriage at any Multi Use Parking Place.
- 11. No person shall leave a vehicle in a Multi Use Parking Place at any time during the Permitted Hours unless he:-
- 11.1 has paid the Initial Charge specified in Article 34 in accordance with the provisions of Article 35 and displays the Parking Ticket on that vehicle in accordance with Article 36; or
- 11.2 is the holder of a valid Disabled Persons Badge and he displays such Badge on that vehicle in accordance with Article 62; or
- 11.3 is the holder of a valid Residents Parking Permit or a valid Business Parking Permit or a valid Carers Parking Permit or a valid Visitors Parking Permit in respect of the Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he displays such Permit on that vehicle in accordance with Article 61.
- 11.4. is the holder of a valid Visitors Parking Voucher or a valid Business Visitor Parking Voucher (in the Baltic Triangle and the Prescot Street Areas only) in respect of the Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he has validated and displays such Voucher in accordance with Article 63.
- 12. In the event that a person leaves a vehicle in a Multi Use Parking Place at any time outside the Permitted Hours and that vehicle remains at that Parking Place at the commencement of the next Permitted Hours that person shall then:-
- 12.1 pay the Initial Charge specified in Article 34 in accordance with the provisions of Article 35 and display the Parking Ticket on that vehicle in accordance with Article 36; or
- 12.2 display a valid Disabled Persons Badge on that vehicle in accordance with Article 62; or
- 12.3 display a valid Residents Parking Permit or a valid Business Parking Permit or a valid Carers Parking Permit or a valid Visitors Parking Permit which has been issued to him in respect of the Parking Place at which the permit is left on that vehicle in accordance with Article 61; or
- 12.4 validate and display a Visitors Parking Voucher or Business Visitor Parking Voucher (in the Baltic Triangle and the Prescot Street Areas only) which has been issued to him in respect of the parking place at which the voucher is left on that vehicle in accordance with Article 63.
- 13. Subject to the exceptions set out in Article 15 no person shall leave a vehicle at a Multi Use Parking Place during the Permitted Hours for a period exceeding 2 hours.
- 14. Subject to the exceptions set out in Article 15 where a vehicle has been left in a Multi Use Parking Place during the Permitted Hours and is then taken away from that Parking Place the vehicle shall not be left at that Parking Place again until one hour has elapsed from the time at which the vehicle was taken away from that Parking Place or the Permitted Hours have expired whichever is the earlier.
- 15. The restrictions as to the maximum length of time for which a vehicle may be left in a Multi Use Parking Place as specified in Article 13 and the restrictions on returning to a Multi Use Parking Place specified in Article 14 shall not apply to vehicles on which there is displayed:-
- 15.1 a valid Disabled Persons Badge in accordance with Article 62;
- 15.2 a valid Residents Parking Permit or Carers Parking Permit or Business Parking Permit or a valid Visitors Parking Permit authorising that vehicle to park at the parking place at which the vehicle has been left in accordance with Article 61; and
- 15.3 a valid Visitors Parking Voucher or Business Visitors Parking Voucher (in the Baltic Triangle and the Prescot Street Areas only) authorising that vehicle to park at the Parking Place during the period for which the vehicle has been left there in accordance with Article 63.

Residents Parking Places

- 17. No person shall leave a vehicle at a Residents Parking Place during the Permitted Hours unless:-
- 17.1.1 he is the holder of a valid Residents Parking Permit, Visitors Parking Permit, or Carers Parking Permit in respect of the Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he displays such Permit on that vehicle in accordance with Article 61; or
- 17.1.2 he is the holder of a valid Visitors Parking Voucher in respect of the Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he has validated and displays such voucher on that vehicle in accordance with Article 63.
- 10. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though there were included the new Article 33A (Limited Waiting Parking Bays) and Articles 33B-33D (inclusive) (Business Parking Places) as shown below in this Order: -

Limited Waiting Parking Bays

33A. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours specified in Column 5 of the Schedule 37 on the days specified in Column 4 of the said Schedule, in the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule to this Order: - (a) for a longer period than that specified in Column 6 of the said Schedule; or (b) if a period of less than that specified in Column 7 of the said Schedule has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same length of road or side of length of road.

Business Parking Places

- 33B. No person shall leave a vehicle other than a Passenger Vehicle, Goods Vehicle, Motor Cycle with a side car fitted or Invalid Carriage at any Business Parking Place specifically described as such within in Part IV of Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 33C. No person shall leave a vehicle in a Business Parking Place specifically described as such within in Part IV of Schedule 1 at any time during the Permitted Hours unless he:-
- 33C.1. is the holder of a valid Business Parking Permit in respect of the Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he displays such Permit on that vehicle in accordance with Article 61.
- 33C.2. is the holder of a valid Business Visitor Parking Voucher in respect of the Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he has validated and displays such Voucher in accordance with Article 63.
- 33D. In the event that a person leaves a vehicle in a Business Parking Place specifically described as such within in Part IV of Schedule 1 at any time outside the Permitted Hours and that vehicle remains at that Parking Place at the commencement of the next Permitted Hours that person shall then:-
- 33D.1. display a valid Business Parking Permit which has been issued to him in respect of the Parking Place at which the permit is left on that vehicle in accordance with Article 61; or
- 33D.2. validate and display a Business Visitor Parking Voucher which has been issued to him in respect of the parking place at which the voucher is left on that vehicle in accordance with Article 63.

<u>Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects PART IV (PROVISIONS AS TO PERMITS, VOUCHERS AND BADGES)</u>

11. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing Article 46 (Business Parking Permit), Article 48 (Visitors Parking Vouchers), Article 49 (Business Visitors Parking Vouchers) and Article 61 (Display of Permit) were substituted by the new Article 46 (Business Parking Permit), Article 48 (Visitors Parking Permits And Vouchers), Article 49 (Business Visitors Parking Vouchers) and Article 61 (Display of Permit) as shown below in this Order: -

Business Parking Permits

46. The Council may issue a Business Parking Permit permitting a specified vehicle to park during the Permitted Hours in a Multi Use Parking Place (which is specified within Part II of Schedule 1) or a Business Parking Place (which is specifically described as such within Part IV of Schedule 1) within an area specified by the Council to an applicant who satisfies the Council that he:-

- 46.1. is regularly carrying on a business of which he has a controlling interest at premises fronting or sufficiently proximate to a Multi Use Parking Place (which is specified within Part II of Schedule 1) or a Business Parking Place (which is specifically described as such within Part IV of Schedule 1); and
- 46.2. has no suitable parking facility within a reasonable distance of such business premises; and
- 46.3. is the owner of a Passenger Vehicle, a Dual Purpose Vehicle, a Goods Vehicle, an Invalid Carriage or a Motor Cycle with side car fitted, or a Solo Motor Cycle (or if he is not the owner of such a vehicle that he has the permission of the owner of such a vehicle to use such a vehicle from the premises referred to in Article 37.1 above); and
- 46.4. has paid to the Council the charge of £140.00 in respect of the issue of a Permit for 3 months if that Permit is designated for the use outside the Baltic Triangle area; and
- 46.5. has paid to the Council the charge of £50.00 in respect of the issue of a permit for 12 months if that Permit is designated for use in the Baltic Triangle Area and Prescot Street Area.

Visitors Parking Permits And Vouchers

- 48. The Council may issue either: up to 100 Visitors Parking Vouchers per calendar year, each valid for a period of 1 day, or a Visitors Parking Permit. Such Vouchers or permits allow a vehicle to park during the Permitted Hours in Residents Parking Places or Multi Use Parking Places within a Parking Zone specified by the Council; to an applicant who satisfies the Council that:-
 - 48.1 his Principle Place of Residence is a Dwellinghouse fronting or sufficiently proximate to a Residents Parking Place or a Multi Use Parking Place;
 - 48.2 he has no suitable parking facility within a reasonable distance of such Dwellinghouse; and
 - 48.3 he is regularly visited by a non-resident who is the owner of a Passenger Vehicle, Goods Vehicle, Invalid Carriage or a Motor Cycle with side car fitted, or a Solo Motor Cycle.

Business Visitors Parking Vouchers

- 49. The Council may issue Business Visitor Parking Vouchers permitting a vehicle to park during the Permitted Hours in a Multi Use Parking Place (which is specified within Part II of Schedule 1) within the Baltic Triangle Area and Prescot Street Area or a Business Parking Place (which is specifically described as such within Part IV of Schedule 1) for a period of 1 day in respect of each voucher to an applicant who satisfies the Council (or any Organisation appointed on behalf of the Council) that:-
- 49.1. he regularly carries out a business of which he has a controlling interest at premises within the Baltic Triangle Area or the Prescot Street Area (which is specified within Part II of Schedule 1) or a Business Parking Place (which is specifically described as such within Part IV of Schedule 1); and
- 49.2. such business premises do not have any suitable off-street parking facility; and
- 49.3. that there is no suitable parking facility which could be reasonably used by visitors to that business within a reasonable distance of such business premises; and
- 49.4. that the applicant has paid to the Council the charge of £1.50p in respect of each voucher to be used.

Display of Permit

- 61. A Permit issued under the provisions of this Order shall be displayed as follows:-
- 61.1. in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen on the near side thereon and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; or on the vehicle dashboard or fascia, so that the date and time recorded on the Permit are clearly visible to a person standing at the front or nearside of such vehicle for the whole of the time during which such vehicle is left at the Parking Place; or
- 61.2. in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects PART VI (MISCELLANEOUS)

12. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing Article 73 (Power To Suspend The Use Of Parking Place) and Article 77 (Removal Of Vehicle From Parking Place) were substituted by the new Article 73 (Power To Suspend The Use Of Parking Place) and Article 77 (Removal Of Vehicle From Parking Place) as shown below in this Order: -

73. Power to Suspend Use of Parking Place

- 73.1. Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:-
- 73.1:1. for the purposes of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
- 73.1:2. for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the Parking Place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Parking Place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the Parking Place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any Telecommunications apparatus, Traffic Sign or Pay And Display Machine;
- 73.1:3. for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or Dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- 73.1:4. on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
- 73.1:5. for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- 73.2. A Civil Enforcement Officer may suspend for not longer than TWENTY FOUR HOURS the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
- 73.3. Any person suspending the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 73.1 or paragraph 73.2 of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of that Parking Place the use of which is suspended a Traffic Sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- 73.4. Whenever a Parking Place is suspended in accordance with Article 73.1 then the Council may make an administrative charge of £25 for each request for a single consecutive period of suspension of each Parking Place and a charge of:-
- 73.4:1. £18.00 per day (or part thereof) in respect of each Parking Space (or part thereof) suspended from use which is comprised within a Pay and Display Parking Place specified in Part I of Schedule 1; or
- 73.4:2. £18.00 per day (or part thereof) in respect of such Parking Space (or part thereof) suspended from use which is comprised within a Multi-Use Parking Place specified in Part II of Schedule 1; or
- 73.4:3. £18.00 per day (or part thereof) in respect of each Parking Space (or part thereof) suspended from use which is comprised within a Long Stay Pay and Display Parking Place specified in Part III of Schedule 1; or
- 73.4:4. £18.00 per day (or part thereof) in respect of each Parking Space (or part thereof) suspended from use which is comprised within a Business Parking Place specifically described as such within Part IV of Schedule 1; or
- 73.4:5. £18.00 per day (or part thereof) in respect of each Parking Space (or part thereof) suspended from use which is comprised within a Car Club Parking Place in Schedule 32.
- 73.5. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any part of a Parking Place during such period when a Traffic Sign is placed in or adjacent to that part of the Parking Place pursuant to paragraph 73.3 of this Article provided that this paragraph shall not apply to a vehicle:-

- 73.5:1. being used by the respective Fire or Police Authority or National Health Trust to deal with an emergency; or
- 73.5:2. being used for any purpose specified in Article 75.1:2 or 75.1:4; or
- 73.5:3. left in such Parking Place with the permission of the person suspending the use of the Parking Place or a Civil Enforcement Officer.

77. Removal of Vehicle from Parking Place

- 77.1. Where a Civil Enforcement Officer is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 32, 33, 33A or 33B of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a Parking Place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the Parking Place and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle. Any expenses incurred by the Council in removing a vehicle from any Parking Place shall be recoverable by the Council from the Owner of the vehicle.
- 77.2. The Council may as respects a vehicle which has been removed from a Parking Place in pursuance of Article 77.1 of this Order, if it appears to them to have been abandoned, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle after having made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle in accordance with the procedure set out in the Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978.

<u>Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects Areas Of Highway Designated As Areas of Highway Designated as Parking Places with Ticket Issuing Machines and/or Requiring the Display of Permits and/or Vouchers Part II – Outer Zone (Multi-Use Parking Places)</u>

13. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Part II** of **Schedule 1** the existing outer zone road numbered **277A** was omitted from the Order (**PART B**).

Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects Areas Of Highway Designated As Areas of Highway Designated as Parking Places with Ticket Issuing Machines and/or Requiring the Display of Permits and/or Vouchers Part III – Outer Zone (Long Stay Pay & Display Parking Only – Up To A Maximum Of Four Hours)

14. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Part III** of **Schedule 1** the new outer zone roads numbered **457A**, **457B**, and **488** were included as specified in **Schedule 1** (**PART A**) to this Order.

Variation the Order of 2009 as respects Areas Of Highway Designated As Areas of Highway Designated as Parking Places with Ticket Issuing Machines and/or Requiring the Display of Permits and/or Vouchers Part IV – Outer Zone (Business Parking Places)

15. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Part IV** of **Schedule 1** the new outer zone road numbered **485** was included as specified in **Schedule 2** (**PART A**) to this Order.

<u>Variation the Order of 2009 as respects Areas of Highways Designated As Residents Parking Places</u> (Outer Zone)

- 16. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Schedule 2: -
- (a) The new outer zone road numbered 489 was included as specified in Schedule 3 (PART A) to this Order.
- (b) The new outer zone road numbered 493 was included as specified in Schedule 3 (PART B) to this Order.

<u>Variation the Order of 2009 as respects Areas of Highways Designated As Parking Places For Loading And Unloading (Outer Zone)</u>

The area covered by this Variation Order is defined as being that part of the Liverpool University Area which includes: - Arrad Street, Brownlow Hill (from its junction with Paddington to a point coincident with the north easterly kerb line of Great Newton Street (extended)), Cambridge Street, Duckinfield Street, Mulberry Place, Mulberry Street, Myrtle Street (from its junction with Hope Street to its junction with Grove Street), Oxford Street, Paddington (from its junction with Brownlow Hill to its junction with Minshull Street) and Peach Street.

Stationary Vehicles Offences for the purposes of this Variation Order are defined as those relating to restrictions on the waiting, loading, unloading and parking of vehicles.
