The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.11) Order, 2009

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on 18th the day of November 2009 and may be cited as The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.11) Order, 2009.

2. Interpretation

- (1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2009 shall have the same respective meaning.
- (2) Furthermore, in this Order the expression "Order of 2009" means The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) Order 2009, as amended by The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.1) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.2) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.3) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Experimental Variation No.5) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.6) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.6) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.7) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.8) Order, 2009; The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.9) Order, 2009; and The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.10) Order, 2009.
