The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.27) Order, 2011

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 4th day of April 2011 and may be cited as: - The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.27) Order, 2011.

2. Interpretation

(1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2009 shall have the same respective meaning.

- (a) The existing inner zone road numbered **79A** was omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 1** to this Order.
- (b) The new inner zone roads numbered 79A and 79C were included as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

<u>Variation Of Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas On The Highways Designated As Disabled Persons' Parking Places (Inner Zone)</u>

4. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 5** the new inner zone road numbered **79** was included as specified in **Schedule 3** to this Order.
