The City Council of Liverpool in exercise of its powers under **Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53** and **Part IV** of **Schedule 9** to **The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the **Chief Officer of Police** in accordance with **Part III** of **Schedule 9** to **The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the **25th** day of **May 2009** and may be cited as:
- **The City Council of Liverpool (Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Order, 2009) (Variation No.1) Order, 2009.**

2. Interpretation

(1) Furthermore, in this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2009 shall have the same respective meaning.

(2) Furthermore, in this Order the expression "Order of 2009" means **The City Council of Liverpool Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone Order, 2009.**

3. Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects Arrangement Of Articles

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in the **Arrangement Of Articles** there were included the new references to **Article 8A (Public Service Vehicle Parking Places)** and **Article 35A (Exemptions from Waiting Restrictions on Restricted Roads – Bus Stop Clear Ways (For Information Only))** as shown below in this Order: -

4. Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects Arrangement Of Schedules

The Order of 1998 and the Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in the **Arrangement Of Schedules** there were included the new references to **Schedule 15 (Areas Of Highway Designated As Public Service Vehicle Parking Places)** and **Schedule 16 (Roads And Parts Of Roads Designated As Bus Stop Clear Way - (For Information Only))** as shown below in this Order: -

5. Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects Interpretations

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Article 2 (Interpretations)**: -

(a) There were included the new interpretations for “**Bus Stop Clear Way**” (For Information Only) and “**Public Service Vehicle Parking Place**” as specified below in this Sub-Article -

*“**Bus Stop Clear Way**” (For Information Only) means any area of highway described in Schedule 16.*

*“**Public Service Vehicle Parking Place**” means any area of highway described in Schedule 15.*

(b) The existing interpretations for “**Controlled Hours**” and “**Parking Place**” was substituted by the revised interpretations for “**Controlled Hours**” and “**Parking Place**” as specified below in this Sub-Article -

*“**Controlled Hours**” means:- (a) in respect of Parking Places (except Doctors Parking Places) the period between 5.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays between the months of August and May inclusive; (b) in respect of each Doctors Parking Places specified in Column 1 of Schedule 8 means the period specified in the corresponding part of Column 6 of Schedule 8; and (c) in respect of any Bus Stop Clear Way (For Information Only) the period between 5.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays between the months of August and May inclusive.*

*“**Parking Place**” means each of the areas on a highway described in Schedule 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 15 where vehicles may park subject to the restrictions and provisions set out in this Order.*

6. Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects PART II – RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF PARKING PLACES

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though there were included the new **Article 8A (Public Service Vehicle Parking Places)** as specified below: -

Public Service Vehicle Parking Places

8A. No person shall leave any vehicle at any Public Service Vehicle Parking Place at any time other than a Public Service Vehicle.

7. Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects PART IV – RESTRICTIONS IN RESPECT OF CERTAIN ROADS OTHER THAN PARKING PLACES

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though there were included the new **Article 35A (Exemptions from Waiting Restrictions on Restricted Roads – Bus Stop Clear Ways (For Information Only))** as specified below: -

Exemptions from Waiting Restrictions on Bus Stop Clear Ways

35A Nothing in Article 33 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any Bus Stop Clear Way: -

(a) if the vehicle is used for fire brigade purposes or an ambulance, or any vehicle in the service of a Local Authority or police force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(b) if the vehicle is a Public Service Vehicle allowing passengers to board or alight, to stop or stop for the purpose of loading and unloading.

8. Variation of both the Order of 1998 and the Order of 2009 as respects PART V – MISCELLANEOUS

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing **Article 42 (Restriction Of Selling From Vehicles At Parking Places)** and **Article 45 (Removal Of Vehicle From Parking Place)** were substituted by the revised **Article 42 (Restriction Of Selling From Vehicles At Parking Places)** and **Article 45 (Removal Of Vehicle From Parking Place)** as specified below: -

Restriction of selling from Vehicles at Parking Places

42. No person shall use any vehicle while it is in a Parking Place during the Controlled Hours, in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale of his skill in handicraft or his services in any other capacity.

Provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of Goods from a vehicle if the vehicle is one which may be left in a Parking Place in accordance with Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 8A of this Order and the Goods are immediately delivered at or taken into the premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected.

45. Removal of Vehicle from Parking Place

(a) Where a Civil Enforcement Officer is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Article 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 8A, 9 or 10 of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a Parking Place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the Parking Place and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle. Any expenses incurred by the Council in removing a vehicle from any Parking Place shall be recoverable by the Council from the Owner of the vehicle.

(b) The Council may as respects a vehicle which has been removed from a Parking Place in pursuance of Article 45(a) of this Order, if it appears to them to have been abandoned, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle after having made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle in accordance with the procedure set out in The Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978.

9. Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects Areas of Highway Designated as Roads and parts of Roads in which Waiting is prohibited 24 hours each day

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 4**: -

(a) The existing restricted road was omitted from the Order on **Hodder Street** (both sides, from its junction with St Domingo Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres)

(b) There were included, as contained in **Schedule 1** to this Order, the new restricted road on **Hodder Street**.

10. Variation of the Order of 2009 As Respects Areas of Highway Designated as Coach Parking Places

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 9** there were included, as contained in **Schedule 2** to this Order, the new coach parking place on **Priory Road**.

11. Variation of the Order of 2009 As Respects Roads And Parts Of Roads In Which Waiting Is Prohibited For The Purpose Of Loading And Unloading For Twenty Four Hours Each Day

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 14** there were included, as contained in **Schedule 3** to this Order, the new twenty-four hour prohibition of loading and unloading restrictions on **Hodder Street**.

12. Variation of the Order of 2009 as respects the Revocation of Traffic Regulation Orders

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 11** there were included any Traffic Regulation Order made by Liverpool City Council in so far as they related to **no waiting at any time and no loading and unloading between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between the hours of 4.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays (inclusive) on Priory Road (north west of its junction with Utting Avenue).**

13. Variation of the Order of 2009 As Respects Areas of Highway Designated as Public Service Vehicle Parking Places

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in the new **Schedule 15** there were included, as contained in **Schedule 4** to this Order, the new public service vehicle parking place on **Walton Lane.**

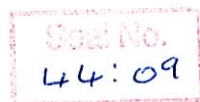
14. Variation of the Order of 2009 As Respects Roads And Parts Of Roads Designated As Bus Stop Clear Way - (For Information Only)

The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in the new **Schedule 16** there were included, as contained in **Schedule 5** to this Order, the new bus stop clear ways (for information only) on **Arkles Lane.**

Priory Road	south west side, from a point 51 metres south east of its junction with Walton Lane in a south easterly direction for a distance of 285 metres with a width throughout of 2.7 metres	Parallel to kerb	19

Walton Lane	east side, from a point 76.5 metres north of its junction with Anfield Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 175 metres with a width throughout of 2.7 metres	Parallel to kerb	11

Schedule 5 - Roads And Parts Of Roads Designated As Bus Stop Clear Way (For Information Only)	
No of Parking Place	Each area described below in this column being an area forming part of the carriageway of a specific highway, is designated as a road or part of road in which stopping or stopping for the purpose of loading and unloading at any time is prohibited for any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle between the hours of 5.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays from the months of August to May inclusive
Arkles Lane	north west side, from a point 27 metres north east of its junction with Anfield Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres
Arkles Lane	north west side, from a point 58 metres north east of its junction with Anfield Road in a north easterly direction to a point 45 metres south west of its junction with Priory Road.
