## The City Council of Liverpool (Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Order 2009) (Variation No.5) Order, 2009

The City Council of Liverpool in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

## 1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of December 2009 and may be cited as: - The City Council of Liverpool (Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Order 2009) (Variation No.5) Order, 2009.

## 3. Variation the Order of 2009 as respects Areas of Highway Designated as Disabled Residents Parking Places


