The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") as amended by The Road Traffic (Parking) Act 1986 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1986") and Section 43 of Schedule 3 of The Road Traffic Act 1991 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1991") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, the Traffic Commissioner for the North West and the Merseyside Passenger Transport Executive in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

**Section One**  
**Commencement, Citation, Interpretations and General Articles**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August 2010 and may be cited as: - The City Council of Liverpool (North – Part 1 Stationary Vehicle Offences) (Consolidation) (Order 2006) (Variation N°50) Order 2010.

2. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2006 shall have the same respective meaning.

3. 4. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

### **Section Two - Variation Of Order Of 2006 As Respects Arrangement Of Articles**

6. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though in the **Arrangement Of Articles** the existing entry for **Articles 15-18 (Residents Parking Places)** was substituted by the new entry for **Articles 15-18 (Residents Parking Places and Pavement Parking Places (In Residents Parking Places))** as specified below in this Order

### **Section Three - Variation Of Order Of 2006 As Respects Section One – Commencement, Citation, Interpretations and General Articles**

7. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though in **Article 2 (Interpretations)** the interpretation of a “**Pavement Parking Place**” was included as specified below in this Order.

“**Pavement Parking Place**” means any area of highway specifically described as such within **Schedule 3** to this Order.

### **Section Four - Variation Of Order Of 2006 As Respects Section Four – Various Parking Places**

8. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though the existing **Articles 15-18 (Residents Parking Places)** were substituted by the **Articles 15-18 (Residents Parking Places and Pavement Parking Places (In Residents Parking Places))** as specified below in this Order.

#### **Residents Parking Places and Pavement Parking Places (In Residents Parking Places)**

*15A. No person shall leave a vehicle at a designated Residents Parking Place as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order during the Permitted Hours unless he is the holder of a valid Residents Parking Permit, Carers Parking*

*Permit or Visitors Parking Permit for that vehicle in respect of the Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he displays such Permit on that vehicle in accordance with Article 32.*

*15B. No person shall leave a vehicle in a Pavement Parking Place specifically described as such within Schedule 3 to this Order in the marked bays fully on the footway bounded by traffic sign to diagram 1033 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 during the Permitted Hours unless he is the holder of a valid Residents Parking Permit, Carers Parking Permit or Visitors Parking Permit for that vehicle in respect of the Pavement Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he displays such Permit on that vehicle in accordance with Article 32.*

*16. The Council may issue a Residents Parking Permit permitting a specified vehicle to park during the Permitted Hours in a Residents Parking Place to an applicant who satisfies the Council that he: -*

*(a) uses as his principle place of residence a dwelling house fronting or sufficiently proximate to a Residents Parking Place or is a Minister of Religion in whose parish is located a Residents Parking Place; and*

*(b) has no suitable parking facility within a reasonable distance of such dwelling house.*

*17. The Council may issue a Carers Parking Permit permitting a vehicle to park during the Permitted Hours in a Residents Parking Place to an applicant who satisfies the Council that he:-*

*(a) is elderly, registered disabled or chronically sick; and*

*(b) uses as his Principal Place of Residence a Dwellinghouse fronting or sufficiently proximate to a Residents Parking Place; and*

*(c) is regularly visited by a person who is a medical practitioner, nurse, midwife or other carer for the purpose of administering care to the applicant; and*

*(d) has no suitable parking facility within a reasonable distance of such Dwellinghouse.*

*18. The Council may issue one Visitors Parking Permit per Dwelling house, permitting a vehicle to park during the Permitted Hours in a Residents Parking Place in a particular road or street specified by the Council for a period of 24 months to an applicant who satisfies the Council that:-*

*(a) his Principle Place of Residence is a Dwellinghouse fronting or sufficiently proximate to a Residents Parking Place;*

*(b) he has no suitable parking facility within a reasonable distance of such Dwellinghouse; and*

*(c) he is regularly visited by a non-resident who is the owner of a Passenger Vehicle, Goods Vehicle, Invalid Carriage or a Motor Cycle.*

**Section Five - Variation Of Order Of 2006 As Respects Schedule 3 (Residents Parking Places and Pavement Parking Places (In Residents Parking Places))**

6. The Order of 2006 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 3 (Residents Parking Places and Pavement Parking Places (In Residents Parking Places))** the new pavement parking place (in a residents parking place) on **Queens Drive, Stoneycroft (north east side)** was included as specified in the **Schedule** to this Order.
