(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE ROAD MARKINGS)
ORDER, 1995

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th day of September 1995 and may be cited as The City Council of Liverpool (Prohibition of Stopping on School Entrance Road Markings) Order 1995.

2. (1) In this Order:-

"school entrance road marking" is the same as a "school keep clear" road marking and means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by such road marking complying with diagram 1027.1 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981.

(2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, to stop on any school entrance road markings in the City, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

4. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
