The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.51) Order, 2012

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of December 2012 and may be cited as: - The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation No.51) Order, 2012.

2. Interpretation

Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Article 2 (Interpretation)

- 5. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Article 2 (Interpretation): -
- (a) The existing interpretations of "Parking Place" and "Permitted Hours" were substituted by the new interpretation of "Parking Place" and "Permitted Hours" as specified overleaf in this Order: -

"Parking Place" means each of the areas on a highway described in Schedules 1 to 13 inclusive and Schedules 25 to 27 inclusive, Schedule 29, Schedules 31 and 32, Schedules 35 to 37 inclusive, Schedule 40 and Schedule 42 where vehicles may park subject to the restrictions and provisions set out in this Order.

"Permitted Hours" means:- (a) in respect of Parking Places (except "Doctors Parking Places", "Coach Parking Places (Restricted Hours)", "Bus Stop Clear Way", "Car Club Parking Place", "Hackney Carriage Clearway", "Street Traders Parking Place" and "Tour Bus Parking Place") the period between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays inclusive; (b) in respect of each "Doctors Parking Places" specified in Column 1 of Schedule 12 means the period specified in the corresponding part of Column 6 of Schedule 12; (c) in respect of each "Coach Parking Places (Restricted Hours)" specified in Column 1 of Schedule 27 means the period specified in the corresponding part of Column 4 of Schedule 27; (d) in respect of each "Bus Stop Clear Way" the period specified in the corresponding part of Column 4 of Schedule 28; (e) at any time in relation to each "Car Club Parking Place" specified in Schedule 32; (f) at any time in relation to each "Hackney Carriage Clearway" specified in Schedule 33; (g) in respect of each "Street Traders Parking Place" specified in Schedule 35 the period between 9.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays inclusive; (h) at any time in relation to each "Tour Bus Parking Place" specifically described as such within Schedule 42.

- (b) The existing interpretations of "Cruise Liner Coach Parking Place" and "Cruise Liner Coach Parking Permit" were omitted as specified below in this Order: -
- "Cruise Liner Coach Parking Permit" means a parking permit issued to a Coach Operator by the City Council under the provisions of Article 54 of this Order.
- "Cruise Liner Coach Parking Place" means any area of highway specifically described as such within Schedule 11 to this Order.
- (c) The new interpretations of "Tour Bus", "Tour Bus Parking Place" "Tour Bus Parking Permit" were included as specified below in this Order: -
- "Tour Bus" means a motor vehicle which being a vehicle adapted to carry more than eight passengers, is used for carrying passengers for hire or reward by a tour bus operator.
- "Tour Bus Parking Place" means any area of highway specifically described as such within Schedule 42 to this Order.
- "Tour Bus Parking Permit" means a parking permit issued to a Tour Bus Operator by the City Council under the provisions of Article 54 of this Order.

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects PART I DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES</u>

6. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing Article 3 (Designation of Parking Places) was substituted by the new Article 3 (Designation of Parking Places) as specified below in this Order:-

Designation of Parking Places

3. Each area on a highway in the City of Liverpool which is described in Schedules 1 to 13 inclusive and Schedules 25 to 27 inclusive, Schedule 29, Schedules 31-32 inclusive, Schedule 35-37 inclusive, Schedule 40 and Schedule 42 of this Order is designated as a Parking Place subject to the restrictions and provisions set out in this Order.

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects PART II RESTRICTION OF USE OF PARKING PLACES</u>

7. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing Article 33 (Cruise Liner Coach Parking Places) was substituted by the new Article 33 (Tour Bus Parking Places) as specified overleaf in this Order: -

Tour Bus Parking Places

33. No person shall leave any vehicle, except a Tour Bus, in a designated Tour Bus Parking Place specifically described as such within **Schedule 42** to this Order at any time unless he is the holder of a valid Tour Bus Parking Permit in respect of the Tour Bus Parking Place at which the vehicle is left and he displays such Permit on that vehicle in accordance with **Article 61**.

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects PART IV PROVISIONS AS TO PERMITS, VOUCHERS AND BADGES</u>

8. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing Article 54 (Cruise Liner Coach Parking Permits) was substituted by the new Article 54 (Tour Bus Parking Permits) as specified below in this Order: -

Tour Bus Parking Permits

54. The Council may issue to an authorised Tour Bus operator one Tour Bus Parking Permit for each bay in a Tour Bus Parking Place specifically described as such within Schedule 42 to this Order permitting a Tour Bus to park during the Permitted Hours in a Tour Bus Parking Bay within a Parking Zone specified by the Council to an applicant who satisfies the Council that he is the owner of the vehicle, or if he is not the owner of such a vehicle that he has the permission of the owner of such vehicle to use such a vehicle from the Tour Bus Parking Place. There will be a fee to acquire each permit which will be determined by the Transportation Manager.

Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas Of Highways Designated As Roads Providing An Exemption from Waiting for Public Service Vehicles When the Vehicle is Waiting During A Layover Period

- 9. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Schedule 4: -
- (a) The existing inner zone road numbered **249** was omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 1** to this Order.
- (b) The new inner zone road numbered 249 was included as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas Of Highways Designated As Parking Places for Coaches</u>

10. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 11** the existing inner zone roads numbered **249A** and **249B** were omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 3** to this Order.

Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Revocation Of Traffic Regulation Orders

11. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 19** the existing Traffic Regulation Order specified in **Column 1** of **Schedule 4** to this Order was revoked to the extent specified in **Column 2** of the said **Schedule** to this Order. (See Article 13(a) of this Order overleaf)

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Roads And Parts Of Roads Designated As Bus Stop Clear Way (For Information Only)</u>

- 12. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Schedule 28: -
- (a) The existing inner zone road numbered **249** was omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 5** to this Order.
- (b) The new inner zone road numbered 249 was included as specified in Schedule 6 to this Order.

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas On The Highways Designated as Drop-Off/Pick-Up Places For Coaches</u>

- 13. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 36:** -
- (a) The existing inner zone road numbered **249** was omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 7** to this Order. (See Article 11 of this Order above)
- (b) The new inner zone road numbered 249 was included as specified in Schedule 8 to this Order.

<u>Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas On The Highways Designated as Tour Bus Parking Places</u>

14. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in the new Schedule 42 the new inner zone roads numbered 249A (TB1), 249B (TB2), 249C (TB3), 249D (TB4), 249E (TB5) and 249F (TB6) were included as specified in Schedule 9 to this Order.
