THE CITY COUNCIL OF LIVERPOOL
(TAGGART AVENUE AREA)
(REVOCATION AND PROHIBITION & RESTRICTION OF WAITING)
ORDER, 1999.

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 13th day of September 1999 and may be cited as The City Council of Liverpool (Taggart Avenue Area) (Revocation And Prohibition & Restriction Of Waiting) Order, 1999.
2. The City Council of Liverpool (Taggart Avenue, Dunbabin Road) (No Waiting) Order, 1964, is hereby revoked in full.
3. The City Council of Liverpool (Woolton Road/Cromptons Lane) (No Waiting) Order, 1968, is hereby revoked in full.
4. The City Council of Liverpool (Woolton Road - Wavertree etc.) (Prohibition And Restriction Of Waiting) Order, 1970, is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the restriction of waiting between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on:-
 - (a) the western side of Green Lane from its junction with Woolton Road in a south westerly direction for a distance of 50 feet; and
 - (b) the western side of Green Lane North from its junction with Woolton Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 50 feet.
5. The City Council of Liverpool (Taggart Avenue And Irene Road) (Revocation and Prohibition Of Waiting) Order, 1993, is hereby revoked in full.

6.(1) In this Order:-

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"**authorised car park**" means any area or category, marked or defined by a road marking complying with **diagram 1028.1** in **Schedule 2** of **The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981**;

"**authorised parking place**" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;

"**disabled person**" means a disabled person of a description prescribed by **Regulation 5** of the **Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982** and **Regulation 6** of the **Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991**;

"**disabled person's badge**" has the same meaning as in **Regulation 3(1)** of the **Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982** and **Regulation 6** of the **Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991**;

"**disabled person's vehicle**" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled person's badge and which is a vehicle, which, immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of a provision of a kind required by **Regulation 3** of the **Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England & Wales) Regulations 1986** to be included in an Order under the 1984 Act, has been or is to be driven by a disabled person or, as the case maybe, has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers.

"**hackney carriage**" has the same meaning as in **Section 38(1)** of the **Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971**;

6.(2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

7. Save as provided in **Article 9** no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the sides or lengths of roads specified in **Column One** of **Schedule One** to this Order to the extent shown in **Column Two** of the said Schedule.

Schedule One	
Column One	Column Two
Calderfield Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Cromptons Lane to a point 13.7 metres east of that junction.
Catonfield Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Cromptons Lane to a point 13.7 metres east of that junction.
Cinder Lane (Both Sides)	From its junction with Cromptons Lane to a point 13.7 metres west of that junction.
Cinder Lane (Both Sides)	From its junction with Green Lane to a point 13.7 metres east of that junction.
Cromptons Lane (Both Sides)	From its junction with Woolton Road to a point 13.7 metres south of its junction with Calderfield Road.
Dunbabin Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Taggart Avenue and Childwall Priory Road to its junction with Terence Road.
Green Lane (Both Sides)	From its junction with Woolton Road to a point 13.7 metres south of that junction.
Green Lane (East Side)	From a point 60 metres north of its junction with Cinder Lane to a point 27 metres south of that junction.
Irene Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Taggart Avenue to a point 13.7 metres west of that junction.

Schedule One (Continued)	
Column One	Column Two
Taggart Avenue (Both Side)	From its junctions with Dunbabin Road and Childwall Abbey Road to its junction with Highville Road.
Taggart Avenue (West Side)	From its junction with Woolton Road to a point 13.7 metres north of its junction with Irene Road.
Taggart Avenue (East Side)	From its junction with Woolton Road to a point 45.7 metres north of that junction.
Woolton Road (North Side)	From a point 45.7 metres east of its junction with Taggart Avenue and Cromptons Lane to a point 134 metres west of that junction.
Woolton Road (South Side)	From a point 45.7 metres east of its junction with Taggart Avenue and Cromptons Lane to a point 27 metres west of its junction with Green Lane.
Woolton Road (South Side)	From a point 63 metres west of its junction with Green Lane to a point 94 metres west of that junction.

8. Save as provided in **Article 9** no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the sides of lengths of roads specified in **Column One** of **Schedule Two** to this Order to the extent shown in **Column Two** of the said Schedule.

Green Lane North (West Side)	From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Irene Road to a point 5 metres north of that junction.
Green Lane North (West Side)	From a point 13.7 metres north of its junction with Woolton Road to a point 44 metres north of that junction.
Green Lane North (East Side)	From a point 13.7 metres north of its junction with Woolton Road to a point 5 metres north of its junction with Irene Road.
Highville Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Taggart Avenue to a point 13.7 metres east of that junction.
Highville Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Stand Park Road to a point 10 metres north of that junction.
Irene Road (North Side)	From a point 13.7 metres west of its junction with Taggart Avenue to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Green Lane North.
Irene Road (South Side)	From a point 35 metres east of its junction with Green Lane North to a point 13.7 metres east of its junction with Towers Road.
Oulton Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Irene Road to a point 5 metres north of that junction.
South Highville Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Taggart Avenue to a point 13.7 metres east of that junction.
Stand Park Road (North Side)	From its junction with Taggart Avenue to a point 13.7 metres east of that junction.
Stand Park Road (North Side)	From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Highville Road to a point 10 metres east of that junction.
Stand Park Road (South Side)	From its junction with Taggart Avenue to a point 10 metres east of its junction with Highville Road.
Terence Road (Both Sides)	From its junction with Irene Road to a point 5 metres north of that junction.
Taggart Avenue (East Side)	From its junctions with Highville Road to a point 13.7 metres south of that junction.

Column One	Column Two
Taggart Avenue (East Side)	From a point 13.7 metres north of its junction with South Highville Road to a point 13.7 metres south of that junction.
Taggart Avenue (East Side)	From a point 45.7 metres south of its junction with Woolton Road to a point 13.7 metres north of its junction with Stand Park Road.

9.(1) Nothing in **Article 7** or in **Article 8** shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the **said sides of lengths of roads** referred to in those Articles, for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely –
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of **the said sides of lengths of roads**;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, **the said sides of lengths of roads** of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in **Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953**;
- (f) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated in or adjacent to **the said sides of lengths of roads**;
- (g) the vehicle to be used in connection with any wedding or funeral;
- (h) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; or
- (i) the vehicle being a disabled person's vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge to be used by a disabled person as defined in the **Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986**.


9.(2) Nothing in **Article 7** or in **Article 8** shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:-

- (a) to wait upon an authorised parking place; or
- (b) being a hackney carriage, to wait upon an authorised cab rank.

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10. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
