**(Order 2009) (Variation No.26) Order, 2014**

The City Council of Liverpool in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

**1. Commencement and Citation**

**This Order shall come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 2014 and may be cited as: - The City Council of Liverpool (Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Order 2009) (Variation No.26) Order, 2014.**

**2. Interpretation**

(1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2009 shall have the same respective meaning.

(2) In this Order the expression "Order of 2009" means **The City Council of Liverpool Football Match Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone Order, 2009** as amended.

**Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects PART IV RESTRICTIONS IN RESPECT OF CERTAIN ROADS OTHER THAN PARKING PLACES**

3. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing **Article 34 (Exemptions from Waiting Restrictions on Restricted Roads - General)** was substituted by the new **Article 34 (Exemptions from Waiting Restrictions on Restricted Roads - General)** as specified below/overleaf in this Order:-

**Exemptions from Waiting Restrictions on Restricted Roads – General**

*34. Nothing in Article 33 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any Restricted Road:-*

*(a) for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle;*

*(b) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to any Restricted Road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in any Restricted Road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any Restricted Road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to any Restricted Road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any Telecommunications Apparatus, wide area traffic control cable, or apparatus or Traffic Signs;*

*(c) if the vehicle is a vehicle used for fire brigade purposes or an ambulance, or any vehicle in the service of a Local Authority or police force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;*

*(d) if the vehicle is a Hackney Carriage waiting upon any duly appointed cab rank;*



(e) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the Driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;

(f) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Postal Operator, British Telecommunications plc or Mercury Communications Limited and is waiting while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to that road are being unloaded from the vehicle or, having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to that road; or is in use in connection with the servicing of telephone kiosks adjacent to that road;

(g) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository, or to such premises from a depository, except that no vehicle shall wait for any such purpose during the period between 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or the period between 4.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. ON ANY DAY OTHER THAN A SUNDAY so far as any such period falls within the Restricted Hours in any part of a Restricted Road specified in Schedule 5, and the period between 8.00 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or the period between 4.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive so far as any such period falls within the Restricted Hours in any part of a Restricted Road specified in Schedule 12, and the period between 5.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive or the period between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays between the months of August and May inclusive so far as any such period falls within the Restricted Hours in any part of a Restricted Road specified in Schedule 13, and the period between 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or the period between 4.00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. ON ANY DAY OTHER THAN A SUNDAY inclusive so far as any such period falls within the Restricted Hours in any part of a Restricted Road specified in Schedule 17 and the period between 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or the period between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. ON ANY DAY OTHER THAN A SUNDAY so far as any such period falls within the Restricted Hours in any part of a Restricted Road specified in Schedule 20, to this Order UNLESS NOTICE IS GIVEN TWENTY FOUR HOURS IN ADVANCE TO THE POLICE OR CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND THEIR CONSENT IS OBTAINED;

(h) if the vehicle is being used in connection with any wedding or funeral;

(i) for a period not exceeding three hours, if the vehicle is displaying a valid disabled person's badge and parking disc/clock and that same vehicle is being used by a disabled person whose badge and parking disc/clock is correctly on display in accordance with the Department for Transport's guidebook, "The Blue Badge Scheme: Rights And Responsibilities In England".

#### **Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas Of Highways Designated As Residents Parking Places**

4. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 1:** -

(a) The existing residents parking place was omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 1** to this Order.

(b) The new residents parking place (permitted parking area) was included as specified in **Schedule 2** to this Order.

#### **Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Areas Of Highways Designated As Unrestricted Parking Places**

5. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 2** the existing unrestricted parking place was omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 3** to this Order.



**Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Roads And Parts Of Roads In Which Waiting Is Prohibited Between The Hours Of 5.00 p.m. And 10.00 p.m. On Mondays To Fridays Inclusive And Between The Hours Of 10.00 a.m. And 6.00 p.m. On Saturdays And Sundays From The Months Of August To May Inclusive**

6. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 3** the existing waiting restriction was omitted from the Order as specified in **Schedule 4** to this Order.

**Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Roads And Parts Of Roads In Which Waiting Is Prohibited Twenty-Four Hours Each Day**

7. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in **Schedule 4** the new waiting restrictions were included as specified in **Schedule 5** to this Order.
