CITY OF LIVERPOOL THE CITY COUNCIL OF LIVERPOOL (BRIDGE ROAD/ROSE LANE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER, 1973

The City Council of Liverpool, in exercise of its powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or of a traffic warden in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the length of road or on the side of the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or of a traffic warden in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7-00 a.m. and 7-00 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on the sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 or in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of roads or in the lengths of road referred to in that Article, as the case may be, for so long as may be necessary:—
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the sides of the roads or the lengths of roads so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said sides of roads or the lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas or water or electricity or any telegraphic line, as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;



- (e) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (f) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said sides of roads or the lengths of road.
- 4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, or by or under any other enactment.
- 5. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of April, 1973, and may be cited as The City Council of Liverpool (Bridge Road/Rose Lane) (Proflibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1973.

SCHEDULE 1

Sides of lengths of road in the City of Liverpool

Bridge Road -the west side -From a point 13.6 metres (45 feet) from its junction with Rose Lane for a distance 190 metres (623 feet) in a northerly direction.

Bridge Road -the east side -From a point 13.6 metres (45 feet) from its junction with Rose Lane for a distance 40 metres (131 feet) north in a northerly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

Length of road and side of length of road in the City of Liverpool

Bridge Road

-From its junction with Rose Lane to a point 13.6 metres (45 feet) from that junction.

Rose Lane —the north side

-From its junction with Bridge Road to a point 18 metres (58 feet) east of that junction.
