The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation N°69) Order, 2015

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 19, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 8^{th} day of June 2015 and may be cited as: - The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (Order 2009) (Variation N°69) Order, 2015.

2. Interpretation

- (1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the several words and expressions for which meanings are assigned by the Order of 2009 shall have the same respective meaning.
- (2) Furthermore, in this Order the expression "Order of 2009" means The Parking Places And Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) Order 2009, as amended.

Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Arrangement Of Schedules

- 3. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though: -

Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects Article 2 (Interpretation)

- 4. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in Article 2 (Interpretation) the new interpretation of "Administration Charge", "Credit Card", "Debit Card", "Hand-held Device", "Location Identification Number", "Mobile Telephone", "Pay-by-Phone" and "Service Provider" were included as specified below in this Order: -
- "Administration Charge" means "Pay-by-Phone" transactions that attract additional charges, payable by the applicant, to cover the administration of the operator and costs incurred during the transaction process. The additional transaction charges should be made public by the operator as part of the transaction process. Telephony charges incurred in the costs of making the transaction depend on network provider and phone service and are the responsibility of the applicant.
- "Credit Card" has the same meaning as in Section 35A of the Act of 1984.
- "Debit Card" has the same meaning as in Section 35A of the Act of 1984.
- "Hand-held Device" means a wireless hand-held computer which is programmed to interface with the Pay-by-Phone parking system and used by a Civil Enforcement Officer to assist in carrying out parking enforcement within any parking place operated by the Council;
- "Location Identification Number" means the unique number assigned to each parking place where the Pay-by-Phone system is operational
- "Mobile Telephone" means any wireless telegraphy apparatus (as defined in The Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949) designed or adapted for the purpose of transmitting and receiving spoken or text messages so as to provide a telephone which is connected to a public electronic communications network (within the meaning of The Communications Act 2003) and is not physically connected to a land line.
- "Pay-by-Phone" means a system of payment whereby the Initial Charge, levied under Article 34 of this Order, (and any appropriate administration charge) is collected by a City Council appointed service provider in accordance with instructions indicated on signs located at on-street parking places where the system is operational, via an arranged account, with payment being made over a mobile telephone or by other electronic system (including via the internet) by credit or debit card or any other means of secure authorised payment, to facilitate a cashless and ticketless parking transaction.
- "Service Provider" means the company authorised and appointed by the Council to operate, administer and maintain the payment of parking charges using the Pay-by-Phone parking system;

Variation Of The Order Of 2009 As Respects PART III PROVISIONS AS TO FAT AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES AND MULTI-USE PARKING PLACES

5. The Order of 2009 shall have effect as though the existing Article 34.1 (Amount of Initial Charge - For Pay and Display Parking Places In The Inner Zone - Mondays to Sundays), Article 34.2 (Amount of Initial Charge - For Multi-Use Parking Places In The Outer Zone -Mondays to Sundays), Article 34.1 (Amount of Initial Charge - For Pay and Display Parking Places In The Inner Zone - Mondays to Sundays), Article 34.3 (Amount of Initial Charge -For Long Stay Pay and Display Parking Places (Up To A Maximum Of Four Hours) In The Outer Zone - Mondays to Sundays), Article 35 (Payment Of Initial Charge), Article 36 (Display of Ticket) and Article 38 (Penalty Charge) were substituted by the new Article 34.1 (Amount of Initial Charge - For Pay and Display Parking Places In The Inner Zone -Mondays to Sundays), Article 34.2 (Amount of Initial Charge - For Multi-Use Parking Places In The Outer Zone - Mondays to Sundays), Article 34.1 (Amount of Initial Charge - For Pay and Display Parking Places In The Inner Zone - Mondays to Sundays), Article 34.3 (Amount of Initial Charge - For Long Stay Pay and Display Parking Places (Up To A Maximum Of Four Hours) In The Outer Zone - Mondays to Sundays), Article 35 (Payment Of Initial Charge), Article 36 (Display of Ticket) and Article 38 (Penalty Charge) as specified below in this Order:-

34. <u>Amount of Initial Charge - For Pay and Display Parking Places In The Inner Zone - Mondays to Sundays</u>

34.1 The Initial Charge payable for a vehicle to be left at a Pay and Display Parking Place specified in Part I of Schedule 1 to this Order, during the permitted hours, for a period not exceeding that specified in Column 1 below shall be the sum specified in the corresponding part of Column 2 below:-

30 minutes	£1.00
1 hour	£2.00
1 hour and 30 minutes	£3.00
2 hours	£4.00
4 hours	£5.00

34. <u>Amount of Initial Charge – For Multi-Use Parking Places In The Outer Zone - Mondays to Sundays</u>

34.2. The Initial Charge payable for a vehicle to be left at a Multi-Use Parking Place specified in Part II of Schedule 1 to this Order, during the permitted hours, for a period not exceeding that specified in Column 1 below shall be the sum specified in the corresponding part of Column 2 below:-

Column 1 – Initial Period	Column 2 – Initial Charge
30 minutes	£1.10
1 hour	£2.20
1 hour and 30 minutes	£3.30
2 hours	£4.40

34. Amount of Initial Charge - For Long Stay Pay And Display Parking Places (Up To A Maximum Of Four Hours) In The Outer Zone - Mondays to Sundays

34.3. The Initial Charge payable for a vehicle to be left at a Long Stay Pay and Display Parking Place specified in Part III of Schedule 1 to this Order, during the permitted hours, for a period not exceeding that specified in Column 1 below shall be the sum specified in the corresponding part of Column 2 overleaf:-

Payment Of Initial Charge

- 35. The Initial Charge shall be paid:
- 35.1 by insertion of the appropriate coin or coins, or Credit or Debit Card in the Pay and Display Machine situated at the Pay and Display Parking Place or Multi Use Parking Place at which the vehicle is left provided that if there is no Pay and Display Machine situated at that Parking Place or such machine is not operating properly the Initial Charge shall be paid by inserting the appropriate coin or coins, or Credit or Debit Card in a Pay and Display Machine which is operating properly and which is nearest to the Parking Place at which the vehicle is left, subject to that machine having the same tariffs as the machine that was not operating properly; or,
- 35.2 by Pay-by-Phone method, in addition to any Administration Charge.
- 35.3 If during the permitted hours a vehicle is left in a parking place and payment of the Initial Charge has been made using the 'Pay-by-Phone' method, payment evidence shall be provided by/obtained from, the City Council's appointed Service Provider.

Display of Parking Ticket

- 36.1 The Parking Ticket issued by the Pay and Display Machine shall be displayed in the vehicle in respect of which the Initial Charge has been paid in a conspicuous position on the vehicle dashboard or fascia, so that the date and time recorded on the Parking Ticket are clearly visible to a person standing at the front or nearside of such vehicle for the whole of the time during which such vehicle is left at the Pay and Display Parking Place or Multi Use Parking Place.
- 36.2 Where notices are displayed at a Parking Place advising of the option of making payment of the Initial Charge by Mobile Telephone (Pay-by-Phone) or by other electronic system (including via the internet) by Credit or Debit card or any other means of secure authorised payment, to facilitate a cashless and ticketless parking transaction and the Initial Charge is duly paid either by Credit Card or Debit Card, in accordance with the instructions indicated on the said notices, then Article 36.10f this Order shall not apply.
- 36.3 If during the permitted hours a vehicle is left in a parking place and the Initial Charge has been paid using the 'Pay-by-Phone' method, evidence shall be provided by/obtained from the City Council's appointed Service Provider as to whether the Initial Period has expired for which the Initial Charge shown on the mobile telephone was paid.

Penalty Charge

- 38. Subject to Article 39 a Penalty Charge of £70.00 or £50.00 shall be incurred if a vehicle is left at any time during the Permitted Hours in a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Multi-Use Parking Place and:-
- 38.1. the Initial Charge has not been paid in respect of that vehicle; or

38.2. the Initial Charge has been paid in respect of that vehicle but the Initial Charge has been paid has expired; or

38.3. the Parking Ticket is not displayed, in accordance with Article 36, for the whole of the time during which such vehicle is left at the Pay and Display Parking Place or Multi Use Parking Place; or

38.4. where notices are displayed near a Parking Place advising of the option of making payment by Mobile Telephone (Pay-by-Phone) or by other electronic system (including via the internet) by Credit or Debit card or any other means of secure authorised payment to facilitate a cashless and ticketless parking transaction and the Initial Charge is duly paid either by Credit Card or Debit Card in accordance with the instructions indicated on the said notices, then Article 38.3 of this Order shall not apply.
