THE CITY COUNCIL OF LIVERPOOL (GATEACRE PARK DRIVE) PROHIBITION OF WAITING ORDER, 1976

The City Council of Liverpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the County Council of Merseyside in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Act of 1967"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of with the permission of a police constable or of a traffic warden in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of lengths of road or on any lengths of roads referred to in that Article, as the case may be, for so long as may be necessary:
- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the sides of lengths of road or the lengths of roads so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said sides of lengths of road or the lengths of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas or water or electricity or any telegraphic line, as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;
- (c) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;



- (d) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said sides of lengths of road or the lengths of roads;
- (e) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.
- 3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967 or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of June, 1976 and may be cited as The City Council of Liverpool (Gateacre Park Drive) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1976.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of roads and sides of lengths of road in the City of Liverpool

1. Gateacre Park Drive - from a point 13.7 metres north of its junction with Wallgate Road to a

point 13.7 metres south of its junction with Grange Lane.

2. Grange Lane - the northeast side .

from its junction with Gateacre Park Drive for a distance of 34 metres.

the southwest side -

from its junction with Gateacre Park Drive for a distance of 13.7 metres.

3. The service road to the rear of Nos. 91-103 Gateacre Park Drive and Barclays Bank Ltd.

from its junction with Gateacre Park Drive for a distance of 24 metres.

4. Rockbourne Avenue

from its junction with Gateacre Park Drive for a distance of 13.7 metres.

5. Thurne Way,

from its junction with Gateacre Park Drive for a distance of 13.7 metres.

6. Wallgate Road

from its junction with Gateacre Park Drive for a distance of 13.7 metres.
