ORDER 2012**

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The Council of the Borough of Luton (hereinafter referred to as "the Council" in exercise of their powers under Sections 35(1) and (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"); the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Bedfordshire Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

**PART 1**

**GENERAL**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> January 2013 and may be cited as the Borough of Luton (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2012.
2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"Civil Enforcement Officer" means a Civil Enforcement Officer appointed by the Council under Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 (C.18);

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Regulation 3(1) of the "The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in the parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"goods vehicle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"loading bay" means a part of a parking place identified by signs and markings in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 as being for the leaving of a goods vehicle;

“motor cycle parking bay” means a parking bay which has been set aside and specifically marked as an area reserved for the parking of motor cycles;

“owner” in relation to a vehicle means the person by whom such vehicle is kept which in the case of a vehicle registered under the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 (C.22); is presumed (unless the contrary is proved) to be the person in whose name the vehicle is registered;

“parking permit” means a parking permit, staff permit, or residents permit of a type and design, issued by the Council for such a period as the Council shall determine from time to time on payment of a appropriate fee, for a vehicle of a specific class and for a specific parking place(s) and subject to such terms and conditions as determined by the Council from time to time and as set out in the terms and conditions of use, in force at the time;

“particulars” means-

- (a) in relation to a ticket, those particulars which indicate that a charge has been paid and the date and time by which the period for which the charge has been paid will expire.
- (b) In relation to a season ticket those particulars which indicate:
  - (1) location for which the permit is valid
  - (2) permit number
  - (3) bay number if applicable
  - (4) date that permit expires
  - (5) registration

“parking bay” means a part of a parking place marked out for the leaving of a vehicle;

“parking meter” means an apparatus or device installed in a parking place which is designed to indicate the time and to issue tickets indicating the payment of a charge and the time at which the vehicle that is to display the ticket ought to leave the parking place;

“parking place” means any area of land specified by name in column 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order provided by the Council under Section 32(1) of the Act for use as a parking place;

“relevant position” in relation to a disabled persons’ badge:- shall have the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

“relevant position” in relation to a blue parking disc/clock is as defined in “the Blue Badge Scheme”: rights and responsibilities in England booklet produced by the Department for Transport October 2007.

## **PART II**

### **USE OF PARKING PLACE**

#### ***Use of Land as Parking Place***

3. (a) Each area specified by name in Column 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order may be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicles, in such manner and on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to it in this Order and in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- (b) Where in the Second Schedule to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place unless it is of a class and in the position so specified.
- (c) A vehicle left in a parking place shall be parked wholly within a parking bay or subject to Article 16 within a loading bay.
- (d) The parking places specified in Column 1 of the said Second Schedule shall be in operation at all times.

#### ***Method of Charge at Parking Place***

4. The driver of a vehicle left in a parking place shall, subject to the provisions of Articles 16, 19 and 22(b) hereof, pay the appropriate charge for the period during which such vehicle is left in such parking place in accordance with the Scale of Charges specified in relation to that parking place in Column 4 of the Second Schedule to this Order.

#### ***Method of Payment of Charge***

5. (a) The charge referred to in Article 4 hereof other than a charge for a season ticket shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in a parking place by the insertion in a parking meter of a bank note or bank notes and a coin or coins of appropriate denominations together making up the amount of the charge.
- (b) Upon payment of the charge referred to in paragraph (a) of this article for a vehicle left in a parking place the driver thereof shall display or cause to be displayed on the vehicle, in accordance with the following provisions of this Article, a ticket issued by the parking meter.
- (c) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a parking place, there shall be displayed on the inside of the vehicle a valid ticket or tickets in the manner indicated on that ticket or those tickets so that all particulars on that ticket as the case may be, are clearly visible from the front and nearside of the vehicle and a vehicle shall not be left in a parking place if it displays an out of date ticket.

Providing that nothing in this Article shall apply to a vehicle displaying a valid season ticket in accordance with Articles 17, 18 or 19 of this Order, or a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge or a motorcycle left in a motor cycle bay or a goods vehicle left in a loading bay.

***Method of payment of charge – telephone payment parking scheme  
Interpretations***

6. (a) "hand held device" means a wireless hand-held computer used by a Civil Enforcement Officer, which is programmed to interface with the telephone payment parking system;

"location identification number" means the unique number assigned to each type of parking bay or parking space within a particular location where the telephone payment parking system is operational;

"mobile telephone parking" means the purchase of parking by using a mobile telephone to facilitate a cashless and ticketless transaction;

"telephone payment parking system" means a system to facilitate and monitor the payment of parking charges using mobile telephone communication with the service provider in accordance with instructions indicated on signs located at each place where the system is operational;

“service provider” means the company authorised and appointed by the Council to operate, administer and maintain the payment of parking charges using the telephone payment parking system;

“service charge” means the charge payable to the service provider (in addition to the parking charge payable in accordance with the provisions of this Order) by persons using the telephone payment parking system.

#### ***Amount of charge at a parking place***

- (b) The driver of a vehicle left in a parking place shall subject to the provisions of this Order, pay the appropriate charge for the period during which such a vehicle is left in such parking place in accordance with the scale of charges specified in relation to that parking place in Column 4 of the Second Schedule to this Order, plus a service charge if payment is made via the telephone payment parking system.

#### ***Method of payment of charge***

(c) Where provision is made for mobile telephone parking this method of payment may be used as an alternative to a ticket machine purchase. As with a ticket machine purchase, payment of the relevant charge in accordance with the scale of charges must be made immediately upon arrival and parking of a vehicle. The driver of a vehicle using this means of payment, may park without physically displaying a valid ticket. In such circumstances reference to electronic proof of purchase will be the means of confirming compliance with the rules of this Article.

#### ***Indications and evidence by the telephone payment parking system***

- (d) Where a vehicle has been left in a parking place referred to in Schedule 2 of this Order, using the telephone payment parking system, an indication that payment has been made and the parking period for which payment has been made shall appear on a hand-held device.

Without prejudice to the provisions of this Order, if at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place referred to in Schedule 2 to this Order and no indication appears in a hand-held device that payment to the parking charge has been made using the telephone payment parking system, or an indication that the parking period for which payment was made has expired, it shall be presumed, unless the contrary is proved, that either:

- a) The parking charge has not been duly paid in respect of that vehicle; or

- b) The parking period for which payment was made has already expired.

***Manner of standing in a parking place for vehicles using the telephone payment parking system***

- (e) Without prejudice to the provisions of this Order, every vehicle left in a parking place of which payment of the parking charge has been made via the telephone payment parking system shall stand wholly within the limits of a parking place, which shall be the appropriate parking place in relation to the location identification number of that parking place.

***Placing of Traffic signs at parking places indicating the telephone payment parking system***

- (f) The Council shall place and maintain traffic signs in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in Schedule 2 to this Order indicating, where applicable:
  - I. That such parking place may be used by vehicles making payment of the parking charge via the telephone payment parking system, and
  - II. The location identification number of such parking place, parking bay or parking space.

***Restriction on Removal of Notices and Tickets***

- 7. When a ticket or notice have been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, no person, other than a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or the driver or a person authorised by the driver in that behalf shall remove the ticket or notice from the vehicle.

***Indications by Parking Meter Tickets and Indications as Evidence***

- 8. (a) Payment of the charge for a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated by the issue by a parking meter installed in that parking place of a ticket indicating that a charge has been paid and the date and time by which the period for which that charge has been paid will expire, and by the display of that ticket in the manner specified in Article 5(c) of this Order.
- (b) The expiry of the period for which a charge has been paid in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated when there is displayed on the vehicle a ticket showing the date and time by which that period will expire, and the date so shown is not the date on which the vehicle is left or the time shown on the clock of the parking meter that issued the ticket is later than the time shown on the ticket.



- (c) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place during the hours specified in relation to that parking place in Column 3 of the Second Schedule to this Order, no ticket is displayed on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 5(c), it shall be presumed that the parking charge has not been duly paid.
- (d) If at any time a vehicle is left in a parking place during the hours specified in relation to that parking place in Column 3 of the Second Schedule to this Order, the ticket or tickets displayed on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 5(c) shows a date that is not the date on which the vehicle is left or the clock on the parking meter that issued the ticket is later than the time shown on that ticket, it shall be presumed that the period of time for which the charge has been paid has expired.
- (e) If it is presumed, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (c) of this Article that the charge has not been duly paid, or in accordance with paragraph (d) of this Article that the period of time for which the charge has been paid has expired, then these indications shall be evidence that a parking contravention, within the meaning of paragraph 4 of Schedule 7 to the Traffic Management Act 2004, has occurred.
- (f) A ticket shall be presumed to have been issued on the date and at the time shown on that ticket.

#### ***Display of Valid Parking Permits***

9. A parking permit issued in accordance with the provisions of this Order shall be displayed:-
- (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen with the obverse side facing forwards; and
  - (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, so that all the particulars on the parking permit are readily visible from outside the vehicle and from the front or near side of the vehicle.

### ***Removal of Vehicle from Parking Place***

10. (a) if a vehicle is left in a parking place in a position other than in accordance with the provisions of Article 3, a Civil Enforcement Officer or another person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions.
- (b) if a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, a Civil Enforcement Officer or another person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the vehicle from that parking place or arrange for such removal.
- (c) for the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a Civil Enforcement Officer or another person authorised by the Council or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place.
- (d) any person altering, or causing the alteration of, the position of a vehicle by virtue of paragraph (a) of this article, or removing, or causing the removal of, a vehicle by virtue of paragraphs (b) or (c) of this Article, may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed.
- (e) any person removing or arranging for the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraphs (b) or (c) of this article shall make such arrangements as he considers to be reasonably necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed.

### ***Restriction Of Use Of Vehicles At Parking Places***

11. No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services and no person shall while a vehicle is in a parking place, affix or place thereon any advertisement.

### ***Exemption from Charges***

12. (1) a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge left in any parking place in column 6 of schedule 2 to this Order shall be exempt from any limitation on time and from any payment of any charge specified in column 4 of schedule 2 to this Order, provided that there is displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle a valid disabled persons badge

(2) nothing in paragraph (1) of this article shall make it lawful for any person to permit a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge to wait in a parking bay in the St. George's Square Car Park for a period exceeding three hours and shall not, within one hour after its leaving, permit it to wait again in any parking bay in that car park.

(3) a vehicle left in any parking place in column 6 of schedule 2 to this Order shall be exempt from any limitation on time and from any payment of any charge specified in column 4 of schedule 2 to this Order, provided it is being used:-

(a) in connection with the carrying out of any of the following operations, namely:-

- (i) building, industrial or demolition works and is of a type that has fixed equipment that is integral to its operation. The vehicle can park for as long as the fixed equipment is in use;
  - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road;
  - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the road, of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any electronic communications network;
- (b) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
- (c) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting and provided that prior agreement with Luton Borough Councils Parking Enforcement Unit has been agreed;
- (d) for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets by a universal service provider in a liveried vehicle.

### ***Parking Bays Reserved for Vehicles Displaying a Valid Disabled Person's Badge***

13. Where, within a parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless there is displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle a disabled person's badge issued by any Local Authority in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000.

### ***Motor Cycle Parking Bays***

14. A motor cycle left in a motor cycle parking bay shall be exempt from any limitation on time and from the payment of any charge specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
15. No person shall leave in a motor cycle parking bay any vehicle other than a motor cycle.

### ***Loading Bays Within Car Parks***

16.
  - (a) Nothing in the preceding articles to this Order shall enable a person to cause or permit a vehicle to wait for the purposes of enabling goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle in any loading bay within any parking place specified in the Second Schedule to this Order unless the vehicle is a goods vehicle.
  - (b) A goods vehicle left in a loading bay within a parking place shall be exempt from the payment of any charge specified for that parking place in the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - (c) Any goods vehicle referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this article shall not wait in any loading bay within any parking place specified in the Second Schedule to this Order for a period of more than thirty minutes and any such vehicle shall not return to such loading bay within a period of one hour of the time of its departure from such loading bay

### ***Season Tickets and Reserved Parking Bays***

17.
  - (a) The owner of a vehicle may on application to the Council purchase a season ticket in respect of a vehicle to be left in a parking place, for the charge specified in relation to that parking place and in relation to the

period of time for which the season ticket is to be valid in column 3 of the Second Schedule to this Order, and the season ticket when displayed on that vehicle in the required manner shall be valid for use in that parking place on the days specified in relation to that parking place in column 3 of that Schedule and the issue of such a season ticket shall not imply reservation of a parking bay.

- (b) In this article and article 18(a); 19(b) and 19(c) of this Order the words “in the required manner” in relation to the display of a season ticket, means the season ticket shall be displayed on the inside of the vehicle so that all the particulars on that season ticket are clearly visible from outside the vehicle.
- 18.
  - (a) Subject to availability the owner of a vehicle may on application to the Council purchase a season ticket, in respect of a vehicle to be parked in a reserved parking bay at Chapel Viaduct Car Park for the charge specified in relation to that parking place and in relation to the period of time for which the season ticket is to be valid in column 3 of the Second Schedule to this Order and that season ticket, when displayed on the vehicle in the required manner, shall be valid for use on any day from Monday to Friday inclusive in such reserved parking bay within the said parking place as may from time to time be allocated by the Council to the applicant.
  - (b) Each reserved parking bay at the Chapel Viaduct Car Park shall be marked indicating that it is a reserved bay within the provisions of paragraph (a) of this article and no person shall leave a vehicle in a reserved parking bay unless there is displayed on the vehicle in the manner specified in article 5 hereof a valid season ticket issued in respect of that parking bay; provided that on a Saturday or Sunday any vehicle of the appropriate class specified in the Second Schedule to this Order in respect of the Chapel Viaduct Car Park and on which there is exhibited a valid ticket, may be left in a reserved parking bay in that parking place.
- 19.
  - (a) The Council may, at its discretion, designate as reserved a parking bay or a group of parking bays in, Beech Hill Car Park, Bells Close Car Park, Birch Link Car Park, Brunswick Street Car Park, Burr Street Car Park, Bute Street Car Park, Chapel Viaduct Car Park, Crawley Road Car Park, Hitchin Road Car Park, Kingsland Road Car Parks 1 & 2, Mostyn Road Car Park, Power Court Car Park, Round Green Car Park, Silver Street Car Park, South Road Car Park, Strathmore Walk Car Park, Taylor Street Car Park, Vicarage Street Car Park and Wenlock Street Car Park.

- (b) Subject to availability, a business may on application to the Council purchase a season ticket, a group of season tickets, in respect of which the Council will allocate a reserved parking bay, or a group of reserved parking bays, in the parking places specified in paragraph (a) of this article for the charge specified in relation to that parking place and in relation to that parking place and in relation to the period of time for which the season ticket is to be valid in column 3 of the Second Schedule to this Order, and that season ticket, when displayed in the required manner shall be valid for use on any day including Sunday in any reserved parking bay allocated by the Council to the business.
- (c) Each business reserved parking bay in the parking places specified in paragraph (a) to this article shall be marked with a sign indicating that it is a reserved bay within the provisions of paragraph (b) of this Article and identifying the business for which it is reserved and no person shall leave a vehicle in that reserved parking bay unless there is displayed on the vehicle in the required manner a valid season ticket issued in respect of that reserved parking bay or group of parking bays.
- (d) The Council may at the request of a business issue without further charge a greater number of season tickets than the number of reserved parking bays allocated to it under the provisions of paragraph (b) of this article but the driver of a vehicle who is in possession of a season ticket issued to that business and who is unable to leave the vehicle in a vacant reserved parking bay allocated to that business and for which that season ticket is valid shall not leave the vehicle in any other parking bay in that parking place without purchasing and displaying a ticket in accordance with article 5 hereof.

## **Residents Parking Permits**

20. (i) Parking permits are available from the council at the appropriate fee, for a vehicle of a specific class and a specific Parking Place or Parking Places subject to conditions determined by the Council. Permits are only available for addresses specified in qualifying addresses in schedule 3 to this Order.
- (ii) the driver shall abide by terms stipulated by the Council for the use of the Parking Permit.
- (iii) a Parking Permit is only valid in the Parking Place or Parking Places as specified in column 5 of schedule 2 to this Order and in respect of which it was issued and up to the date of expiry shown on the Parking Permit.
- (iv) a parking permit remains the property of the Council and must be surrendered on request.
- (v) the driver of the Vehicle shall display the Parking Permit in the relevant position on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the vehicle is left in the parking place.

### ***Replacement of Lost or Damaged Permits***

21. (a) If a parking permit is mutilated or defaced or the figure or particulars on it have become illegible or the colour of the parking permit has become altered by fading or otherwise the parking permit holder shall surrender it to the Council or to the authorised agent and may apply to the Council or to the authorised agent for the issue of a duplicate parking permit and the Council or the authorised agent upon the receipt of the parking permit if such receipt is accompanied by an application for a duplicate parking permit shall issue a duplicate parking permit so marked and on any second or subsequent application for a duplicate parking permit the permit holder shall make payment of a fee of £5.00.
- (b) If a parking permit is lost or destroyed the parking permit holder may apply to the Council or to the authorised agent for the issue of a duplicate parking permit and the Council or the authorised agent upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction shall issue a duplicate parking permit so marked and on any second or subsequent application for a duplicate parking permit the permit holder shall make payment of a fee of £5.00.

- (c) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a revised permit or a duplicate parking permit and an application for a duplicate parking permit as if it were a parking permit or as the case may be an application therefore.

***Method of Proceeding in a Parking Place***

22. Where in the parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:-
- (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place, or
  - (b) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place.

No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance, or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit, so indicated, or (ii) in a direction other than that specified, as the case may be.

23. The driver of a motor vehicle using the parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
24. No person shall, except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in a parking place for any purpose other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.

***Conduct of Persons in a Parking Place***

25. No person shall in the parking place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance of users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.
26. No person shall in the parking place use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.
27. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the



engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

### ***Activities Prohibited in a Parking Place***

28. No person shall use any part of the parking place or any vehicle left in the parking place:-
- (a) for sleeping or camping purposes;
  - (b) for cooking purposes; or
  - (c) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place
29. In the parking place no person shall:-
- (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council; or
  - (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire
30. The amount of any charge due under this Order may be varied by the Council giving Notice in accordance with Section 35C of the Act.

### ***Revocations***

31. The Orders identified in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
