ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Kent County Council ("the Council") acting as the local traffic authority in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), and 4 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:

- 1 This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Borough of Maidstone) Designated Parking Places Order (Variation No. 3) Order 2009" and shall come into operation on the 1st June 2009.
- 2 In this Order the expression "Order of 2008" means "The Kent County Council (Borough of Maidstone) Designated Parking Places Order 2008".
- 3 The Order of 2008 shall have effect as though;
 - (i) In Schedule 1, thereto, the length of roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order were inserted in the correct numerical order.
 - (ii) In Schedule 1 thereto; the details specified in Part IV, article 10 (2) shall be amended to include items, 10, 11a, 11b, 12a, 12b and 12c
 - (iii) In Schedule 2 thereto; the details specified in Part V, article 21 (2) b; charges relating to Residents Parking Permit Charges shall be amended as follows;

A charge of £25, for the issue of the first and £25 for the second Residents' and or Visitors Parking Permit for a year, or any part of a year. And a charge of £50 for a third permit for a year, or any part of a year. This charge will apply to all households remaining in Resident's Parking Zones.
 - (iv) In Schedule 2 thereto, the details specified in Part V, article 21 (2) c; was deleted in its entirety –
- 4 The existing waiting and loading restrictions in the length of roads specified in Schedule 2 of this order are hereby revoked.

**SCHEDULE 1
LENGTHS OF ROAD TO BE INSERTED**

Designated Parking Places at Pay and Display Machines

In relation to a parking place referred to in this schedule the expression “permitted hours” means the period between **Monday to Sunday, 8.00am to 6.00pm** inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday

11b	Brewer Street	South	From a point 118 metres west of its junction with Wheeler Street for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction	1 hour

12b	Union Street	North	From a point 18 metres west of it's junction with Church Street for a distance of 18 metres in a westerly direction	1 hour

PART IV - PARKING AT SPECIFIC TYPES OF PARKING PLACES

Pay and Display Parking Places

10. (1) Except as provided in Articles 19 and 20, no person shall cause any vehicle to wait in a designated parking place specified in a schedule in Part A of the schedules to this Order during the permitted hours unless all of the following conditions are complied with:-

(2) In this Article “permit charge” in respect to a parking place in Schedule 1, means the amount specified in column (3) in relation to the period of waiting specified in column

(2) in relation to item numbers 10,11a,11b,12a,12b,12c of Schedule 1

2.	Between 30 minutes and 1 hour	1.00p

SCHEDULE 2

Albion Place; East side; from a point 12 metres north of its junction with Ashford Road for a distance of 30 metres in a northerly direction.

Brewer Street; South side; from the boundary of 16/18 for a distance of 23 metres in a westerly direction, South side; from a point 118 metres west of its junction with Wheeler Street for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.

Union Street; North side; From a point 15 metres west of its junction with Wheeler St for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction, North Side; from a point 18 metres west of its junction with Church Street for a distance of 18 metres in a westerly direction, North side; from a point 35 metres east of its junction with Week Street for a distance of 6 metres in an easterly direction.
