ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Kent County Council ("the Council") acting as the local traffic authority in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), and 4 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 has made the following Order:

- 1 This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Borough of Maidstone) Designated Parking Places Order (Variation No. 5) Order 2010" and shall come into operation on the 16th May 2011.
- 2 In this Order the expression "Order of 2008" means "The Kent County Council (Borough of Maidstone) Designated Parking Places Order 2008.
- 3 The Order of 2008 shall have effect as though
 - (i) In Schedule's 3 and 8a thereto, the length of roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order were deleted.
 - (ii) In Schedule's 1,2,3,8 and 8a thereto, the length of roads specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order were inserted in the correct numerical order.
 - (iii) The Order of 2008 shall have effect as though in the schedules thereto, the schedule 8b to this order and the lengths of road thereto were inserted.
 - (iv) in Schedule 8a thereto the schedule description "Designated United Reformed Church Parking Places" shall be amended to "Designated Permit Parking Places"

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL has made the above named Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The effect of the first named Order (Waiting Restrictions VARIATION NO.5) will be to introduce new or to extend existing waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL means waiting to be prohibited at all times by double yellow lines; SYL and loading restrictions means no waiting at the times prescribed below).The second named Order (Designated Parking Places VARIATION NO. 5) will affect parking places.
