On the northern side

- (a) from a point 69 metres east of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres;

- (c) from a point 108 metres east of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 14 metres;

- (b) from a point 18 metres west of its junction with Church Street for a distance of 18 metres in a westerly direction;
- (c) from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Wheeler Street for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction;
- (d) from a point 35 metres east of its junction with Week Street for a distance of 6 metres in an easterly direction;
- (e) from a point 11 metres east of its junction with Week Street for a distance of 12 metres in an easterly direction.

WHEELER STREET

On the eastern side from a point 62 metres north of its junction with Union Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 21 metres.
