ADMIRAL WAY

- (1) On the northern side
- (a) From its junction with Goudhurst Road in an easterly direction for 11.5 metres
- (b) From a point 29 metres east of its junction with Goudhurst Road in an easterly direction for 5 metres

- (c) From a point 51.7 metres east of its junction with Goudhurst Road in an easterly direction for 21.6 metres
- (2) On the southern side

From its junction with Goudhurst Road in a westerly direction for 73.4 metres

GOUDHURST ROAD

On the eastern side

(a) From a point 6.5 metres north opposite its junction with Mayes Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 89 metres
