The ~~Council of the County of Kent~~ ^{its} in exercise of ~~their~~ powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, propose to make the following Order:- *(the Act')*

**FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads in Maidstone in the Borough of Maidstone

ASTLEY TERRACE

- (1) On both sides from its junction with Hastings Road for a distance of 30 metres in a easterly direction
- (2) On the eastern side from a point 1 metre south of the southern boundary of No 5 for a distance of 44 metres in a northerly direction
- (3) On the western side
 - (a) from a point opposite 1 metre south of the southern boundary of No 5 for a distance of 26 metres in a northerly direction.
 - (b) From its northern boundary of No 1 for a distance of 13 metres in a southerly direction
- (4) On the northern side from the boundary of No 1 for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.

Roads in Headcorn in the Borough of Maidstone

OAK LANE

(4) On the northern side

- (a) From its western junction with Knaves Acre for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.
- (b) From its eastern junction with Knaves Acre for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.
- (c) From its north-western junction with Grigg Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- (d) From its south-eastern junction with Grigg Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a south-easterly direction.

(5) On southern side

- (a) From its western junction with Chaplin Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.
- (b) From its eastern junction with Chaplin Drive for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.

The following shall be deleted from the First Schedule (~~No Waiting At Any Time~~)

KING STREET

(1) On the northern side

- (d) from a point 55 metres east of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 14 metres;
- (e) from a point 81 metres east of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres;
- (f) from a point 97 metres east of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 11 metres;

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule (~~No Waiting At Any Time~~) in place of the existing entry:

KING STREET

(1) On the northern side

- (d) from a point 19 metres east of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres;
- (e) from a point 57 metres east of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 14 metres;
- (f) from a point 80 metres east of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 30 metres;
