**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 53 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

**REVOCAATION, MODICATION AND AMENDMENTS**

1. "The Kent County Council (Borough of Maidstone) (Waiting Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2017" to be amended as follows; SC

**STREET OR LENGTH OF STREET**  
**WHERE WAITING IS PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME**

**Roads in Maidstone in the Borough of Maidstone**

In Schedule 1 of the Order of 2017 the following shall be inserted in the correct alphabetical order

- LONDON ROAD (1) South-western side, from a point 10 metres southeast of its junction with Queens Road to a point 10 metres northwest of that junction
- QUEENS AVENUE (2) On the north-eastern side  
From its junction with Queens Road in an north-westerly direction for 40 metres
- QUEENS AVENUE (3) On the north-western side  
From its junction with Queens Road in an north-westerly direction for 15 metres
- QUEENS AVENUE (4) Both sides  
From its junction with London Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres

**CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT**

- 3. This Order maybe cited as 'The Kent County Council (The Borough of Maidstone) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Variation No.9 Order 2018' ('the Order') and shall come into operation on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 2018.
