Malvern Hills District Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of Worcestershire County Council in accordance with section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and Citation

- This Order is supplemental to the Principal Order
- This Order shall come into operation on the 9 day of June 2014 and may be cited as the Malvern Hills District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) Amendment (No.1) Order 2014.

Interpretation

- 3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - "the Principal Order" means the Malvern Hills District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2013.
- 4. Except where the context requires otherwise, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article shall be construed as a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order and any reference in this Order to the schedule is a reference to schedules 1 and 2 to this order, otherwise they shall be referred to independently as Schedule 1 or Schedule 2 etc.

- Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment and to any subordinate legislation or by-law made under that enactment.
- 6. Unless the context otherwise requires, words denoting the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and words denoting the persons shall include either gender, bodies corporate, unincorporated associations and partnerships.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

PART 2 AMENDMENTS TO THE PRINCIPAL ORDER

- The Principal Order shall be amended as follows:
- in Schedule 1, the maximum waiting time for Geraldine Road parking place be amended from 2 hours to 4 hours on all days between 00:00 18:00
- in Schedule 1, "Up to 4 hours £2.00" be inserted in the Scale of Charges for Geraldine Road parking place on all days between 00:00 18:00
- in Schedule 1, the scale of charges in respect of HGVs using Hanley Road parking place be amended from £10:00 to £7.00
- in Schedule 3, paragraph 5 insert "New Street" in the column for nominated parking place for eligible properties in Upton-upon-Severn.

NOTICE OF MAKING MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2014

NOTICE is given that Malvern Hills District Council in exercise of its enabling powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, has made the abovementioned Order.

The effect of the Order is to make the following amendments to the Malvern Hills District Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2013 ("the Principal Order"):

- Geraldine Road WR14 3NT: increase the maximum waiting time from 2 hours to 4 hours between the hours of 00:00 18:00 and introduce a new tariff of £2.00 for up to 4 hours
- Hanley Road WR8 OHY: reduce the tariff for HGVs from £10.00 to £7.00
- Season tickets: Upton-upon-Severn season ticket holders be permitted to nominate New Street as their designated parking place

The Order will come into effect on Monday 9 June 2014.

Any person wishing to challenge the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred under the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court.
