## CITY OF MANCHESTER (ALBYNS AVENUE BECKENHAM ROAD AND ESMOND ROAD CHEETHAM MANCHESTER) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2001

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in Column 2 of that Schedule in relation to those lengths of road.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on 10th December 2001 and may be cited as the City of Manchester (Albyns Avenue Beckenham Road and Esmond Road Cheetham Manchester) (One Way Traffic) Order 2001.


Beckenham Road from its junction with Albyns Avenue for a "West to north distance of 63 metres"
