THE CITY OF MANCHESTER (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (MANCHESTER CITY CENTRE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1999

The Council of the City of Mancheter in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 32, 35(1) and Section 35(3) and Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Greater Manchester Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. <u>Citation and Commencement</u>

This Order may be cited as "The City of Manchester (Off-Street Parking Places) (Manchester City Centre) (Amendment) Order 1999" and shall come into operation on 5 April 1999.

2. Interpretation

- In this Order "the Order of 1998" means the City of Manchester (Off-Street Parking Places) (Manchester City Centre) Order 1998;
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted or as having
 affact by virtue of any subsequent enactment;
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 1998 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

3. Amendment of the Order of 1998

Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Order of 1998 shall have effect as though:-

- (a) in Articles 2, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 and in Schedule 2 Part 2 for the words "initial charge" wherever they appear there were substituted the words "parking charge";
- (b) in Article 2 and Schedule 2 Part 1 for the words "initial period" wherever they appear there were substituted the words "parking period";
- (c) Articles 13 and 15 and Schedule 2 Part 2 were deleted therefrom;
- (d) in Article 18 the words "or that an excess charge has been incurred, whether
 by contravention of Article 7, 9, 13, 16 or 21(iii) of this Order or otherwise"
 after the word "contravened" and before the word "he" were deleted therefrom.

Each parking place may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving of vehicles of such classes as are specified in relation to that parking place in Column 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order.

Restriction of use of parking places

- (i) No person shall, except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in a parking place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.
- (ii) No person shall use any vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale or hire of his skill in handicraft or his services in any other capacity other than with the written consent of the Council, without prejudice to any planning or health regulations which may require to be met.
- (iii) No person shall wash, clean or overhaul any vehicle or execute any mechanical or other alterations or repairs to the vehicle while it is in a parking place, except such repairs as may be essential for the purpose of enabling the vehicle to be towed or driven away from the parking place.
- (iv) No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place for sleeping, camping, or cooking.
- (\vee) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- (vi) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or similar instrument except for the avoidance of danger when about to change the position of a vehicle in or depart from the parking place.
- (vii) Where, within a parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled person's vehicle, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in that parking bay unless it is a disabled person's vehicle which is carrying the disabled person and which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970.

- (iv) Any vehicle left in a parking place which displays in the position hereinafter provided a Season Ticket issued by the Council for use in that parking place at that time shall be exempt from the initial charge:-
 - (a) in the case of a two wheeled motor cycle, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle in front of the driving seat; or
 - (b) in the case of all other vehicles, facing forwards on the near side of the glass of the windscreen behind the glass.

The Season Ticket shall be so displayed on the vehicle that the details shown on the front are clearly visible to a person standing beside the vehicle.

Excess charges at parking places

13.

- (i) If a vehicle is left in any parking place during the chargeable hours for longer than the period for which the initial charge has been paid an additional amount (hereinafter referred to as the "excess charge") shall be payable as specified in Part 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
 - (ii) If a vehicle is left in a parking place during the chargeable hours without the initial charge having been paid, a excess charge shall be payable as specified in Part 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
 - (iii) If a vehicle enters or is left in a parking place or parking bay in contravention of the restrictions of use of parking places detailed in Articles 7, 16, or 21 of this Order an excess charge shall be payable as specified in Part 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
 - (iv) If a vehicle is left in a parking place with an out of date ticket on display an excess charge shall be payable as specified in Part 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
 - (v) If a vehicle is left in a parking place for more than twenty four hours after an excess charge has been incurred a further excess charge of £30 shall be incurred in respect of each additional twenty four hour period that the vehicle is left in that parking place.

Power to suspend parking places

21.

 Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary.

- (ii) On any suspension of a parking bay in a parking place in accordance with the provisions of the preceding paragraph, any person duly authorised by the Council, may use suitable means to indicate that the use of the parking bay or parking place is suspended.
- (iii) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any part of a parking place which has been suspended in accordance with the provisions of this Article, except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council.

Power to dispose of abandoned vehicles

22. The Council may, in respect of a vehicle which has been removed from a parking place in pursuance of Articles 18 or 19 of this Order, if it appears to them to have been abandoned, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle after having made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle.

Responsibility of driver

23. The person who was driving the vehicle at the time when it was left in the parking place shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of all relevant Articles of this Order and unless proved to the contrary the registered keeper of the vehicle shall be deemed to be the driver of that vehicle.

Disclaimer

24. The Council shall not be held liable for any damage to, loss of, or theft of/or from any vehicle in any parking place.

Revocations

25. The Orders specified in Schedule 3 to this Order are hereby revoked.
