## <u>CITY OF MANCHESTER (APPLEBY AVENUE AND WILPSHIRE AVENUE,</u> <u>LONGSIGHT, MANCHESTER) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2002</u>

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to the length of road in Column 2 of that Schedule.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on 22 April 2002 and may be cited as the City of Manchester (Appleby Avenue, Longsight, Manchester) (One Way Traffic) Order 2002.
