

CITY OF MANCHESTER (NAPLES STREET, CABLE STREET AND
CORPORATION STREET, MANCHESTER)
(DISABLED PERSON'S PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1993

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the "Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1(1) In this Order:-

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

(2) For the purposes of Column 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the "relevant position" when:-

(a) a disabled person's badge issued before 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position if:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; or

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle; and

(b) a disabled person's badge issued after 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position if:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; or

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle

(c) a parking disc in the relevant position if,

- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.
- 2. Each of the parts of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicles in such positions as are specified in relation to that part of road in the said Schedule.
- 3. Where in the Schedule to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place:-
 - (a) unless it is of the specified class, or
 - (b) if it is in a position other than that specified
- 4. The driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place so as to unreasonably prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by any other person, or so as to be a nuisance.
- 5. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- 6. No person shall use the vehicle whilst it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
- 7. When a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of Articles 3 and 4 of this Order a person authorised in that behalf may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place: Provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 3(b) of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- 8. Any person removing the vehicle or altering its position by virtue of the last preceding Article of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.

distance of 5 metres
in a south westerly
direction and having
a width of 2 metres
throughout
