((No. 1) Order 2003**

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Schedule -Areas on streets designated as parking places

Medway Council, having consulted the Chief Officer of Police, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b) and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

PART I

PRELIMINARY

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Medway (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2003 and shall come into force on * 2003.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires:

"Council" means Medway Council;

"disabled person's badge" and "disabled person's vehicle" have the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000(d);

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description; and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"goods carrying vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description and

is not drawing a trailer;

"one-way street" means a street in which the driving of vehicles otherwise than in one direction is prohibited;

"parking attendant" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any parking place;

"parking place" means any area on a street designated as a parking place by this Order;

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than twelve passengers (exclusive of the driver), and their effects and not drawing a trailer;

"permitted hours" in relation to a parking place means at any time;

"Schedule" means the Schedule to this Order;

"street" includes part of a street;

"telecommunication system" has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984(a).

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

(3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

(4) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position when it is so regarded for the purpose of Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000(b).

PART II

DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES

Designation of parking places

3. Each area on a street comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule and, unless otherwise so specified, bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 1.83 metres is designated as a parking place.

Vehicles for which parking places are designated

4. Each parking place may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving during the permitted hours of such disabled person's vehicles as display in the relevant position a disabled person's badge.

PART III

SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

Manner of standing in a parking place

5. The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place during the permitted hours in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall cause it so to stand:
- (a) in the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place are specified in column 3 of the Schedule as to be in accordance with those provisions;
 - (b) in the case of any other parking place:
 - (i) if the parking place is not in a one-way street, that the left or near side of the vehicle is adjacent to the left-hand edge of the carriageway; and
 - (ii) that the distance between the edge of the carriageway and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres; and
 - (c) that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking place; and
 - (d) that no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting.

Power to suspend the use of a parking place

6. (1) Any person duly authorised by the Council or the Chief of Police may suspend the use during the permitted hours of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:

- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
- (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the parking place, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway or the cleansing of gullies in or adjacent to the parking place, the laying erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign;
- (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture to or from one office or dwellinghouse adjacent to the parking place from or to a depository, another office or dwellinghouse;
- (d) on any occasion when it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
- (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on any other special occasions.

(2) A police constable or a parking attendant in uniform may suspend for not more than twenty four hours the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.

(3) On the suspension of the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with provisions of this Article, the person authorising or causing such suspension shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or that part thereof, as the case may be, traffic signs indicating that the waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

(4) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any parking place or any part thereof at any time during the permitted hours and during which there is displayed in or adjacent to that parking place or that part thereof, as the case may be, a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (3) of this Article:

Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall apply:

- (i) in respect of any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle which is waiting for any reason specified in Article 8(1)(b), (d) or (e); or
- (ii) to anything done with the permission of the person suspending the

use of the parking place or part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (1) of this Article, a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant.

Restriction on the use of a parking place

7. During the permitted hours no person shall use any parking place or any vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the selling or offering for sale of this skill in handicraft or his services in any other capacity:

Provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of offering or exposing for sale of goods from a vehicle if the vehicle is one to which the provisions of Article 8(1)(h) apply.

Restriction on waiting by a vehicle in a parking place

8. (1) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, any vehicle may wait during the permitted hours in any part of a parking place if the use of that part has not been suspended and if:

- (a) the vehicle is waiting for a period not exceeding two minutes or such longer period as a police constable or a parking attendant in uniform may approve to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage:

Provided that if the said person is a person suffering from any disability or injury which seriously impairs his ability to walk, or who is blind the vehicle may wait for so long as may be necessary to enable that person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage;

- (b) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (c) the vehicle is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or, not being a passenger vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or the performance of such duties for the vehicle such duties for the vehicle to wait in the parking place in which it is waiting;
- (d) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable

it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

- (e) the vehicle is waiting:
 - (i) while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the vehicle or, having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered; or
 - (ii) while postal packets are being collected for loading on the vehicle from premises or postal boxes adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting or, having been so collected, are being loaded thereon;
- (f) the vehicle not being a passenger vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in Article 6(1)(b);
- (g) the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture to or from one office or dwellinghouse adjacent to the parking place from or to a depository or another office or dwellinghouse; or
- (h) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting and the vehicle does not wait for such purpose for more than twenty minutes or such longer period as a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant may approve.

(2) Except as provided by this Order, the driver or person in charge of a vehicle shall not cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place during the permitted hours.

Manner of waiting in a parking place

9. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place by virtue of the provisions of paragraph 1(e), (f), (g) or (h) of the last preceding Article otherwise than so that:

- (a) in the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place are specified in column 3 of Schedule 1 so that the vehicle shall stand:
 - (i) unless the length of the vehicle precludes compliance with this subparagraph, in accordance with those provisions and so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place; or

- (ii) if the length of the vehicle does preclude compliance with the last preceding sub-paragraph, so that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres; and
- (b) in the case of any other parking place, so that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres; and
- (c) no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting.

For the purposes of the last foregoing sub-paragraph, the expression "premises" shall not include any premises to or from which any furniture is being removed by virtue of the provisions of paragraph (1)(g) of the last preceding Article or to or from which goods are being delivered or collected by virtue of the provisions of paragraph (1)(h) of that Article.

Movement of a vehicle in a parking place in an emergency

10. A police constable or a parking attendant in uniform may move or cause to be moved, in case of emergency to any place he thinks fit, any vehicle left unattended in a parking place.

Placing of traffic signs

11. The Council shall place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place and that each parking place may only be used by vehicles referred to in Article 4.
