

Medway Council, having consulted the Chief of Police, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) and (2) and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) ("The Act") as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b) and the Traffic Management Act 2004(c) and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 31st March 2008 and may be cited as the Medway Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No.1) Order 2008.
2. In this Order "enactment" means any enactment, whether public, general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done to or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Medway (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Order 2003 shall have effect as though: -
 - (a) There were added after the wording "The Local Government Act 1985" in the first paragraph of that Order the wording "and the Traffic Management Act 2004(c)";
 - (b) there were substituted for the wording "Parking Attendant" in Articles 2(1) and 9(1)(c)(ii) of that Order the wording "Civil Enforcement Officer in relation to parking contraventions".
