(CONSOLIDATION) (NO. 2) ORDER 2017**

Medway Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹ and of all other enabling powers, and having consulted the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

PART 1

GENERAL

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into force on 6th November 2017 and may be cited as the Medway Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (No. 2) Order 2017.

Revocation

2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order specified in Schedule 1 to this Order is hereby revoked

Interpretation

3. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires:-

"Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"bank holiday" means a day which is a bank holiday within the meaning of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971², as well as Christmas Day and Good Friday;

"bay markings" means white or yellow lines marked on the surface of a parking place or any variation in material, pattern or colour of the surface of a parking place which is designed to indicate a parking bay;

"charging hours" means the period of time specified in column 5 of an item in Schedule 2 during which the parking charge is payable for the leaving of a vehicle in the parking place specified in column 2 of that item;

"civil enforcement officer" means a civil enforcement officer appointed by the Council under section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"coach" means a bus that is a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 passengers (exclusive of the driver);

"Council" means Medway Council;

"credit card" and "debit card" have the same meanings as in section 35A(6) of the Act of 1984;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Regulation 3(1) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000³;

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public, general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"hand-held device" means a wireless hand-held device which is programmed to interface with the telephone or electronic payment system or the parking permit electronic management system or both;

"hard-copy type", in relation to a permit or a season ticket, means the permit, or season ticket as the case may be, is issued by the Council on paper or card or other similar material;

"heavy goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden or any description, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 3.5 tonnes;

"Jezreels season ticket" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 25;

"late night" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 24;

"overnight car park permit season ticket" means a season ticket under the provisions of Article 22:

"light goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description, the maximum gross weight of which is 3.5 tonnes or less;

"long stay parking bays" means parking bays within a parking place in which vehicles may be left for a parking period exceeding 6 hours, subject to the provisions of this Order, and which are indicated by the words "Long Stay" placed on the surface of that parking place or on upright signs in that parking place or on both the surface and upright signs;

"maximum gross weight" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016⁴;

"motor cycle" has the same meaning as in section 136(4) of the Act of 1984 and includes a motor cycle that has a side car attached;

"multiple car park permit season ticket" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 18;

"non-resident's any car park season ticket" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 17;

"operational times", means the period of time specified in column 4 of an item in Schedule 2 during which the parking place specified in column 2 of that item is open, excluding any time during which the parking place is closed under the provisions of Article 30;

"parking charge" means an amount specified in column 8 of an item in Schedule 2 which is payable, subject to the provisions of this Order, at a ticket machine or via the telephone or electronic payment system in respect of a vehicle left in the parking place specified in column 2 of that item for the parking period specified in relation to that parking charge in the said column 8;

"parking bay" means an area within a parking place which is provided for the leaving of one vehicle only and is indicated by bay markings;

"parking period" means a period of time specified in column 8 of an item in Schedule 2 for which payment of the parking charge specified in relation thereto has been made in respect of a vehicle, and during which, subject to the provisions of this Order, that vehicle may be left in the parking place specified in column 2 of that item during the charging hours;

"parking permit electronic management system" means a computer system set up by the Council to keep a record of the registration marks of the vehicles in respect of which virtual permits have been issued, the parking places in which such vehicles may be left and whether such permits are valid, and that is linked electronically to a hand-held device on which those records can be displayed for the purpose of determining whether a vehicle left in a parking place has been granted a virtual permit to park there and whether that permit is valid;

"parking place" means an area of land or building, that is provided by the Council under section 32(1)(a) of the Act of 1984 for use as an off-street parking place and is specified by name in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2;

"particulars" means –

- (a) in relation to a ticket, an indication that the parking charge has been paid and the date and time of expiry of the parking period;
- (b) in relation to a hard-copy type season ticket or hard-copy type permit–
 - (i) the registration number of the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued;
 - (ii) the period during which it is valid;
 - (iii) an indication that the season ticket is either a multiple car park season ticket, a resident's any car park season ticket, a non-resident's any car park season ticket, a single car park season ticket, a shopper's season ticket, a Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket, a Rochester late night season ticket, a late night season ticket, a overnight car park permit season ticket or a Jezreels season ticket, as the case may be, or that the permit is a worshipper's permit, or a resident's G Zone permit as the case may be;

- (iv) in the case of a single car park season ticket, a late night season ticket or a worshipper's permit, the name of the parking place in respect of which such a season ticket or permit is valid;
- (v) an indication that it has been issued by the Council;

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle) constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than eight passengers (exclusive of the driver) and their effects and not drawing a trailer;

"permit", without more, means either a worshipper's permit or a resident's G Zone permit;

"relevant position" means:

- (a) in relation to the display by a vehicle of a disabled person's badge, the same as in Regulation 4(1) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
- (b) in relation to the display by a vehicle of a valid ticket, hard-copy type season ticket or hard-copy type permit—
 - (i) on the inside of the windscreen or on the dashboard of the vehicle; or
 - (ii) where the vehicle does not have a windscreen or dashboard, in a conspicuous position on the front of the vehicle;

"resident's G Zone permit" means a permit issued or granted under the provisions of Article 15(1) of The Medway Council (Gillingham and Brompton) (Parking Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2016⁵;

"resident of Medway" means a person whose usual place of abode is at an address in the area for which the Council is the unitary authority and who provides such documents as are required to be seen by the Council to prove that their usual place of abode is at such an address;

"resident's any car park season ticket" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 16;

"restricted area" means any area of a parking place which is a pavement or a grassed area or which is indicated by:

- (a) double yellow lines, similar to the road marking diagram 1018.1 shown in column (3) of item 1 of the sign table set out in Part 4 of Schedule 7 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016, marked on the surface of that parking place; or
- (b) hatched or cross-hatched markings on the surface of that parking place;

"Rochester late night season ticket" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 23;

"Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 21;

"season ticket", without more, means either a resident's any car park season ticket, a non-resident's any car park season ticket, a multiple car park season ticket, a single car park season ticket, a shopper's season ticket, a Rochester late night season ticket, a late night season ticket, a overnight car park permit season ticket, a Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket or a Jezreels season ticket being either of a hard-copy type or of a virtual type;

"service provider" means the contractor authorised by the Council to accept payment of the parking charge on its behalf and to keep a record of that parking charge and the vehicle, the parking place and the parking period in respect of which that payment has been made via the telephone or electronic payment system;

"shopper's season ticket" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 20;

"single car park season ticket" means a season ticket issued under the provisions of Article 19;

"short stay parking bays" means parking bays within a parking place in which vehicles may be left for a parking period of 6 hours or less, subject to the provisions of this Order, and which are indicated by the words "Short Stay" placed on the surface of that parking place or on upright signs in that parking place or on both the surface and upright signs;

"telephone or electronic payment system" means an electronic system, using a telephone connection or electronic application set up and maintained by the service provider whereby:

- (a) the driver of a vehicle, or some other person authorised by that driver on their behalf, uses a telephone or electronic apparatus to communicate with the service provider and make payment of the parking charge in respect of a specified vehicle and a specified parking place and for a specified parking period by use of a debit or credit card, in accordance with instructions given by the service provider at the time of using the system; and
- (b) the service provider, on behalf of the Council, accepts payment of the parking charge by the method referred to in paragraph (a) of this definition and records such payment together with the parking period for which payment has been made, the parking place in which the vehicle is left, and the registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which payment has been made;

"ticket" means a ticket issued by a ticket machine in accordance with either Article 10(2)(a) or 10(2)(b) which indicates that the parking charge has been paid and the date and time of expiry of the parking period;

"ticket machine" means an apparatus or device installed in a parking place in accordance with section 35(3) of the Act of 1984 and Article 5 of this Order, which is designed to accept payment of the parking charge and to issue a ticket;

"worshipper's permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Article 26.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

(3) Any reference in this Order to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

Contraventions

4. If a vehicle is left in a parking place without complying with the provisions of this Order, then a contravention of this Order or a failure to comply with the provisions of this Order shall be deemed to have occurred, and a parking contravention within Part 1 of Schedule 7 to the Traffic Management Act 2004⁶ in so far as that Part is applicable, shall be deemed to have occurred.

Installation of ticket machines and provision of telephone or electronic payment system

5. The Council shall install and maintain a ticket machine or ticket machines in each parking place in such position or positions as they think fit and shall provide a telephone or electronic payment system as a means of collecting the parking charge.

PART II

CONDITIONS OF USE OF PARKING PLACES

Conditions of use of a parking place during its operational times

6. During the operational times of a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 (such operational times being those specified in column 4 of that item):—

- (a) no vehicle shall enter or be left in that parking place unless that vehicle is of the class specified in column 3 of that item;
- (b) no vehicle shall be left in that parking place other than in a parking bay:
 - Provided that nothing in this sub-paragraph shall apply where there are no parking bays in the parking place;
- (c) no vehicle shall be left in that parking place in a restricted area;
- (d) where, within that parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge, a vehicle shall not be left in that parking bay unless it is displaying a valid disabled person's badge in the relevant position;
- (e) where, within that parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for motorcycles, a vehicle shall not be left in that parking bay unless it is a motorcycle;
- (f) where, within that parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay or area is reserved for the leaving of certain vehicles only (such vehicles to be those authorised by written agreement with the Council), a vehicle shall not be left in that parking bay or area unless it is one of those vehicles;

- (g) no vehicle shall be left in that parking place in such a position that it causes an obstruction;
- (h) for the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a civil enforcement officer, a person authorised by the Council or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from the parking place;
- (i) any person removing or arranging for the removal of a vehicle by virtue of subparagraph (h) of this Article shall make such arrangements as are reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Conditions of use of a parking place during the charging hours

7. (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this Article, throughout the entire time that a vehicle is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item, it shall display in the relevant position a valid ticket, so that all the particulars on that ticket are clearly visible from outside the vehicle and from the front of the vehicle:

Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall apply:

- (a) if the driver of that vehicle or a person authorised by the driver to act on their behalf has paid the parking charge specified in column 8 of that item for the parking period specified in relation thereto, by using the telephone or electronic payment system and such payment has been accepted by the service provider;
- (b) to any vehicle left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which there is specified in column 8 of that item an exception from the parking charge for a vehicle:
 - (i) that displays a certain valid hard-copy type season ticket or valid hard-copy type permit, and throughout the entire time that the vehicle is left in that parking place it displays in the relevant position one of those season tickets or permits, so that all the particulars thereon are clearly visible from outside the vehicle and from the front of the vehicle; or
 - (ii) in respect of which there has been granted a certain valid virtual type season ticket or valid virtual type permit, and throughout the entire time that the vehicle is left in that parking place the grant of such a season ticket or permit shall be indicated by the appearance on a hand-held device of an indication that one of those season tickets or permits has been granted by the Council in respect of the vehicle and in respect of the parking place in which the vehicle is left and that the season ticket or permit is valid,

Provided that if the season ticket or permit is only valid during certain times or on certain days, as specified in Article 26(4), 26(6), 26(7), 26(9) or 26(10), then the proviso described in this sub-paragraph shall only apply during those times or days as the case may be;

- (c) to any vehicle left in Globe Lane Car Park, Chatham (specified in item 20 of Schedule 2) if it displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge;
- (d) to any motor cycle which is left in a parking bay in respect of which there is a sign or surface marking indicating that the parking bay is available only for a motor cycle;
- (e) to any vehicle which is left in a reserved bay or a reserved area of a parking place provided the vehicle is authorised, by written agreement with the Council, to be left in such a parking bay or area.

(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall apply in relation to a vehicle left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 if there are no charging hours specified in column 5 of that item or if the words "not applicable" are specified in that column.

Conditions relating to short stay and long stay parking bays

8. (1) Where, in relation to a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 there is an indication in that column that there are both short stay parking bays and long stay parking bays within that parking place:-

- (a) a vehicle displaying a ticket which indicates payment of the parking charge specified in column 8 of that item in relation to short stay parking bays shall not be left in a long stay parking bay;
- (b) a vehicle displaying a ticket which indicates payment of the parking charge specified in column 8 of that item in relation to long stay parking bays, shall not be left in a short stay parking bay;
- (c) a vehicle in respect of which the parking charge specified in column 8 of that item in relation to short stay parking bays has been paid via the telephone or electronic payment system, shall not be left in a long stay parking bay; and
- (d) a vehicle in respect of which the parking charge specified in column 8 of that item in relation to long stay parking bays has been paid via the telephone or electronic payment system, shall not be left in a short stay parking bay.

(2) If a vehicle is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item in contravention of any of the provisions of sub-paragraph (1)(a) or (1)(b) of this Article, the ticket displayed on that vehicle shall not be valid.

Conditions relating to time limits (maximum period) and "no return" periods

9. (1) No vehicle displaying a ticket shall be left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item (or during the operational times specified in column 4 of that item if the charging hours are not applicable) for longer than the maximum period (if any) specified in column 7 of that item.

(2) Where a vehicle displaying a ticket has been taken away from a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2, during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item (or during the operational times specified in column 4 of that item if the charging hours are not applicable), it shall not be returned to that parking place during those charging hours or operational times, as the case may be, until the "no return" period (if any) specified in column 7 of that item has expired, such period having started at the time the vehicle was taken away from the parking place.

PART III

PARKING CHARGES, DISPLAY OF TICKETS ETC AND PAYMENT BY TELEPHONE OR ELECTRONIC PAYMENT SYSTEM

Payment of the parking charge at a ticket machine and display of a ticket or payment of the parking charge via the telephone or electronic payment system

10. (1) The parking charge for a vehicle left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 at any time during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item, shall be the amount specified in column 8 of that item immediately following the parking period for which payment of that parking charge is made.

(2) Subject to paragraph (4) of this Article, the parking charge shall be payable on the leaving of a vehicle in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item:-

- (a) by the insertion in a ticket machine installed in that parking place of the appropriate coins or bank notes, or a combination of coins and bank notes, accepted by the mechanism of that ticket machine, together making up the amount of the parking charge specified in column 8 of that item for the parking period for which payment is being made, and on such payment a ticket issued by the ticket machine shall be obtained;
- (b) where the ticket machine installed in that parking place accepts a valid credit card or a debit card, by the insertion in that ticket machine of such a card which shall be debited with the amount of the parking charge specified in column 8 of that item for the parking period for which payment is being made, and on such payment a ticket issued by the ticket machine shall be obtained; or
- (c) by the driver of the vehicle, or a person authorised by the driver to act on their behalf, instructing the service provider to accept payment of the parking charge specified in column 8 of that item for a specified parking period and in respect of a specified vehicle left in a specified parking place, by using the telephone or electronic payment system and by the service provider accepting such payment,

and by following the instructions for payment of the parking charge as indicated on that ticket machine or as indicated on a sign relating to that parking place or as indicated by the service provider, as the case may be.

(3) Upon payment of the parking charge in the manner specified in paragraph (2)(a) or (b) of this Article, the driver shall display or cause to be displayed on the vehicle the ticket issued by the ticket machine following payment of the parking charge, so that all the particulars on that ticket are clearly visible from outside the vehicle and from the front of the vehicle.

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (2) of this Article, a vehicle left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which there is specified in column 8 of that item an exception from the parking charge for a vehicle that displays a certain valid hard-copy type season ticket or valid hard-copy type permit, or in respect of which there has been granted a certain valid virtual type season ticket or valid virtual type permit, shall be exempt from payment of the parking charge if throughout the entire time that the vehicle is left in that parking place:

- (a) it displays in the relevant position one of those hard-copy season tickets or hard-copy type permits, so that all the particulars thereon are clearly visible from outside the vehicle and from the front of the vehicle; or
- (b) in respect of that vehicle there has been granted one of those virtual type season tickets or virtual type permits, and throughout the entire time that the vehicle is left in that parking place the grant of such a season ticket or permit shall be indicated by the appearance on a hand-held device of an indication that one of those season tickets or permits has been granted by the Council in respect of the vehicle and in respect of the parking place in which the vehicle is left and that the season ticket or permit is valid:

Provided that if the season ticket or permit displayed, or granted as the case may be, is only valid during certain times or on certain days, as specified in Article 26(4), 26(6), 26(7), 26(9) or 26(10), then the exemption from payment of the parking charge described in this paragraph shall only apply during the times or on the days that the season ticket or permit is valid.

Indications by ticket and ticket machine or hand held device

11. (1) Payment of the parking charge in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated:-

- (a) where such payment has been made at a ticket machine in accordance with either Article 10(2)(a) or 10(2)(b), by the issue by a ticket machine situated in that parking place of a ticket indicating that the parking charge has been paid and the date and time of the parking period, and by the display of that ticket in the manner specified in Article 10(3);
- (b) where such payment has been made via the telephone or electronic parking system in accordance with Article 10(2)(c), by the appearance on a hand-held device of an indication that the parking charge has been paid and accepted in respect of that vehicle by the use of that system and an indication of the date and time of expiry of the parking period for which that parking charge has been paid and accepted.

(2) Where payment of the parking charge has been made at a ticket machine in accordance with either Article 10(2)(a) or 10(2)(b), the expiry of the parking period in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated when there is displayed on that vehicle a ticket showing the date and time at which the parking period expires and the date so shown is not the date on which the vehicle is left or the time shown on the clock of the ticket machine that issued the ticket is later than the time of expiry of the parking period shown on the ticket.

(3) Where payment of the parking charge has been made via the telephone or electronic payment system in accordance with Article 10(2)(c), the expiry of the parking period in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated when there is displayed on a hand-held device an indication that the parking period for which payment of the parking charge has been made, has expired.

Ticket and ticket machine indications and hand-held device indications as evidence

12. (1) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item, no ticket is clearly displayed on that vehicle in accordance with Article 10(3) and no indication appears on a hand-held device that payment of the parking charge has been made in accordance with Article 10(2)(c), it shall be presumed that the vehicle has been left in that parking place without payment of the parking charge.

(2) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item:-

- (a) the ticket displayed on that vehicle in accordance with either Article 10(2)(a) or 10(2)(b) shows a date that is not a date on which the vehicle is left; and
- (b) no indication appears on a hand-held device that the parking charge has been paid and accepted in respect of that vehicle via the telephone or electronic payment system on the date on which the vehicle is left,

it shall be presumed that the vehicle has been left in that parking place without payment of the parking charge.

(3) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item:-

- (a) there is a ticket displayed on that vehicle in accordance with Article 10(3) showing the date on which the vehicle is left but the clock on the ticket machine that issued the ticket shows a time that is later than the time of expiry of the parking period shown on that ticket: or
- (b) an indication appears on a hand-held device showing that the parking charge has been paid on the date on which the vehicle is left but the clock on that hand-held device shows a time that is later than the time of expiry of the parking period for which the hand-held device shows a parking charge has been paid,

It shall be presumed that the vehicle has been left in that parking place with the parking charge duly paid in respect of that vehicle and the parking period has expired.

Other provisions relating to the display of tickets

13. (1) When a ticket is displayed on a vehicle in accordance with Article 10(3) of this Article, no other ticket or tickets shall be displayed on that vehicle at the same time.

(2) Once a ticket has been displayed on a vehicle left in a parking place in accordance with Article 10(3), that ticket shall not be transferred to and displayed on another vehicle under any circumstance.

Validity of tickets

14. (1) A ticket displayed on a vehicle left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 shall only be valid if:-

- (a) it has been obtained from a ticket machine installed in the parking place in which the vehicle is left, following payment of a parking charge specified in column 8 of that item;
- (b) it is displayed in the relevant position throughout the entire time that the vehicle is left in that parking place, so that all the particulars on that ticket are clearly visible from outside the vehicle and from the front of the vehicle;
- (c) the expiry time of the parking period shown upon that ticket has not elapsed;
- (d) it has not previously been displayed on another vehicle; and
- (e) the particulars on that ticket have not been altered or added to.

Payment of a parking charge to extend the parking period beyond the initial time

15. (1) Subject to paragraph (3) of this Article, when payment of the parking charge has been made at a ticket machine in accordance with either Article 10(2)(a) or 10(2)(b) in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place and a ticket has been displayed on that vehicle in accordance with Article 10(3), then no further payment of a parking charge shall be made at that ticket machine or at any other ticket machine nor shall the telephone or electronic payment system be used to make payment of a further parking charge, so as to extend the parking period beyond that initially paid for.

(2) Subject to paragraph (3) of this Article, when payment of the parking charge has been made via the telephone or electronic payment system in accordance with Article 10(2)(c) in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place, then no further payment of the parking charge shall be made via the telephone or electronic payment system nor by making further payment of a parking charge at a ticket machine, so as to extend the parking period beyond that initially paid for.

(3) Nothing in paragraph (1) or (2) of this Article shall apply in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2, if there is an indication in column 6 of that item that a further payment of the parking charge so as to extend the parking period beyond that initially paid for may be made, such indication being when the word "Yes" is specified in that column.

PART IV

SEASON TICKETS AND PERMITS

Application for and issue of a resident's any car park season ticket

16. (1) Any resident of Medway may apply to the Council for the issue of a resident's any car park season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a resident's any car park season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council, upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident of Medway shall issue to the applicant one resident's any car park season ticket.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in any parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item and in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a valid resident's any car park season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge specified in that column.

Application for and issue of a non-resident's any car park season ticket

17. (1) Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of an any car park season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a non-resident's any car park season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council shall issue to the applicant one non-resident's any car park season ticket.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in any parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item and in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a valid non-resident's any car park season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge specified in that column.

Application for and issue of a multiple car park permit season ticket

18. (1) Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a multiple car park permit season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a multiple car park permit season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council, upon being satisfied shall issue to the applicant one multiple car park permit season ticket.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in any parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item and in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a valid multiple car park permit season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge specified in that column.

Application for and issue of a single car park season ticket

19. (1) Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a single car park season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a single car park season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council shall issue to the applicant one single car park season ticket for use in one parking place selected by the applicant from the parking places specified in column 2 of the items in Schedule 2 in relation to which there is specified in column 8 of those items an exemption from payment of the parking charge for vehicles displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a valid single car park season ticket and the name of the parking place selected shall be indicated by name on that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that season ticket is of a virtual type.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in the parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 which is indicated by name on that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that season ticket is of a virtual type, during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item.

Application for and issue of a shopper's season ticket

20. (1) Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a shopper's season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a shopper's season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council shall issue to the applicant one shopper's season ticket.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in any parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item and in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a valid shopper's season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge specified in that column:

Provided that the season ticket allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in the Balmoral Gardens Car Park, Gillingham (specified in item 3 of Schedule 2) only on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Application for and issue of a Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket

21. (1) Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council shall issue to the applicant one Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in any parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item and in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a valid Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge specified in that column.

Application for an overnight car park permit season ticket

22. (1) Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of an overnight car park permit season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a overnight car park permit season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council shall issue to the applicant one overnight car park permit season ticket for use in one parking place selected by the applicant from the parking places specified in column 2 of the items in Schedule 2 in relation to which there is specified in column 8 of those items an exception from payment of the parking charge for vehicles displaying or in respect of which there has been granted an overnight car park permit season ticket, and the name of the parking place selected shall be indicated by name on that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that season ticket is of a virtual type.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in the parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 which is indicated by name on that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that season ticket is of a virtual type, during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item.

Application for and issue of a Rochester late night season ticket

23. (1) Any person whose usual place of abode is at:-

- (a) Nos. 2 to 198 (even numbers inclusive) High Street, Rochester (paved area);
- (b) Nos. 1 to 177 (odd numbers inclusive) High Street, Rochester (paved area);
- (c) Nos. 1 to 3 Gundulph Square, Rochester;
- (d) Senlac House, Gundulph Square, Rochester;
- (e) Crow Corner, Crow Lane, Rochester;
- (f) Nos. 2 to 6 Crow Lane, Rochester;
- (g) Nos. 1 to 9 Bishops Walk, Rochester;
- (h) The Chimes, Bishops Walk, Nos. 1 to 9;
- (i) the property that is related to PO Box 51, Almon Place, Rochester; or
- (j) Star Hill, Rochester - all properties,

may apply to the Council for the issue of a Rochester late night season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a Rochester late night season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant's usual place of abode is at a property specified in sub-paragraphs (a) to (j) of this paragraph, shall issue to the applicant one Rochester late night season ticket.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in any parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item and in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a valid Rochester late night season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge specified in that column.

Application for and issue of a late night season ticket

24. (1) Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a late night season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a late night season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council shall issue to the applicant one late night season ticket for use in one parking place selected by the applicant from the parking places specified in column 2 of the items in Schedule 2 in relation to which there is specified in column 8 of those items an exception from payment of the parking charge for vehicles displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a late night season ticket, and the name of the parking place selected shall be indicated by name on that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that season ticket is of a virtual type.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left, without payment of the parking charge, in the parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 which is indicated by name on that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that season ticket is of a virtual type, during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item.

Application for and issue of a Jezreels season ticket

25. (1) Any person whose usual place of abode is at:-

- (a) Nos. 44 to 110 (even numbers inclusive) Rainham Road, Gillingham; or
- (b) Nos. 85 to 135 (odd numbers inclusive) Rainham Road, Gillingham,

may apply to the Council for the issue of a Jezreels season ticket in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(1), together with the charge specified for a Jezreels season ticket in Schedule 3, the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant's usual place of abode is at a property specified in sub-paragraphs (a) or (b) of this paragraph, shall issue to the applicant one Jezreels season ticket.

(2) The season ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article allows the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued or granted to be left in Jezreels Car Park, Gillingham (specified in item 29 of Schedule 2), without payment of the parking charge.

Application for and issue of a worshipper's permit

26. (1) Any person who regularly attends a place of worship in the area for which the Council is the unitary authority may apply to the Council for the issue of a worshipper's permit in respect of a passenger vehicle, a light goods vehicle or a motor cycle. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of this paragraph and in accordance with Article 25(2), together with the charge specified for a worshipper's permit in Schedule 3, the Council, upon being satisfied that the applicant regularly attends at such a place of worship, shall issue to the applicant one worshipper's permit to leave the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued in the parking place that is nearest that place of worship, subject to that parking place being one of those specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which there is specified in column 8 of that item an exemption from payment of the parking charge for vehicles displaying or in respect of which there has been granted a valid worshipper's permit, and the name of the parking place shall be indicated by name on that permit.

(2) The worshipper's permit referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article shall be a permit to leave the vehicle in respect of which it has been issued, without payment of the parking charge, in the parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 which is indicated by name on that worshipper's permit if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that permit is of a virtual type, during the charging hours specified in column 5 of that item.

Additional conditions relating to season tickets and worshipper's permits

27. (1) An application for a season ticket shall be made via an online form or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied.

(2) An application for a worshipper's permit shall be made via an on-line form or on a form issued by and obtainable from a religious leader who is authorised by the Council to issue such application forms and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied and shall be signed by that religious leader.

(3) The Council may at any time require an applicant for a resident's any car park season ticket or a multiple car park permit season ticket or a late night permit or an overnight car park permit season ticket or a Rochester late night season ticket or a Jezreels season ticket or a worshipper's permit or the holder of one of those season tickets or the holder of a worshipper's permit to produce such evidence as it may reasonably require to verify any information given by the applicant or holder of the season ticket or worshipper's permit to verify that any season ticket, or worshipper's permit as the case may be, is valid and in particular such information shall include evidence of the applicant's or season ticket/permit holder's usual place of abode.

(4) The issue of a season ticket or a worshipper's permit does not entitle the vehicle in respect of which such a season ticket or permit has been issued to be left in a reserved parking bay, nor can a parking bay or space be guaranteed.

(5) Where the holder of a hard-copy type season ticket or a hard-copy type worshipper's permit wishes to surrender that season ticket, or that permit as the case may be, to the Council, the refund (if any) shall be calculated in the manner specified on the application form for the issue of that season ticket, or permit as the case may be.

(6) Where the holder of a virtual type season ticket or a virtual type worshipper's permit wishes to cancel such a season ticket, or that permit as the case may be, the refund (if any) shall be calculated in the manner specified on the application form for the issue of that season ticket, or permit as the case may be.

(7) The Council may, at its discretion, issue season tickets or worshipper's permits of a hard-copy type only or grant them of a virtual type only.

(8) For the purposes of the issue of a penalty charge notice, where there is no indication displayed on a hand-held device that a virtual type season ticket or virtual type permit has been granted in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place or there is an indication on a hand-held device that a virtual type season ticket or virtual type permit has been so granted but it is not valid, then this shall be construed as being equivalent to the penalty charge notice offence of being parked without clearly displaying a valid permit where required.

Validity of season tickets and permits

28. (1) A resident's any car park season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying, or in respect of which there has been granted, a valid resident's any car park season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge.

(2) A non-resident's any car park season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying, or in respect of which there has been granted, a valid non-resident's any car park season ticket, shall be excepted from the parking charge.

(3) A multiple car park permit season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying, or in respect of which there has been granted, a valid multiple car park permit season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge.

(4) A single car park season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in the parking place indicated by name on that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that season ticket is of a virtual type.

(5) A shopper's season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying, or in respect of which there has been granted, a valid shopper's season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge:

Provided that where a vehicle displaying, or in respect of which there has been granted, a shopper's season ticket is left in Balmoral Gardens Car Park, Gillingham (specified in item 3 of Schedule 2) that season ticket shall only be valid on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

(6) A Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying, or in respect of which there has been granted, a valid Rochester Riverside Multi-Storey Car Park season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge.

(7) A Rochester late night season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying, or in respect of which there has been granted, a valid Rochester late night season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge, and the vehicle is left in that parking place between 7 p.m. on one day and 9 a.m. on the following day.

(8) A late night season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in the parking place indicated by name on that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or on a hand-held device if that season ticket is of a virtual type, between 7 p.m. on one day and 9 a.m. on the following day.

(9) A overnight car park permit season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in a parking place specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 in relation to which it is specified in column 8 of that item that a vehicle displaying, or in respect of which there has been granted, a valid overnight car park permit season ticket shall be excepted from the parking charge, and the vehicle is left in that parking place between 7 p.m. on one day and 9 a.m. on the following day.

(10) A Jezreels' season ticket shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that season ticket if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that season ticket if it is of a virtual type, is left in Jezreel's Car park, Gillingham (specified in item 20 of Schedule 2).

(11) A worshipper's permit shall only be valid when the vehicle displaying that permit if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that permit if it is of a virtual type, is left in the parking place indicated by name on that permit if it is of a hard-copy type or on a hand-held device if that permit is of a virtual type on a Sunday or a bank holiday.

(12) A resident's G Zone permit shall only be valid for the purposes of this Order when the vehicle displaying that permit if it is of a hard-copy type, or in respect of which there has been granted that permit if it is of a virtual type, is left in Medway Park Car Park, Gillingham (specified in item 37 of Schedule 2) between 6 p.m. on one day and 10 a.m. on the following day.

(13) In addition to the provisions of paragraphs (1) to (10) inclusive of this Article, a hard-copy type season ticket or hard-copy type permit shall only be valid if:-

- (a) it is displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued;
- (b) the registration mark of the vehicle displaying that season ticket, or permit as the case may be, is the same as the registration mark indicated on that season ticket or permit;

- (c) it is displayed on the inside of the vehicle and on the front of that vehicle so that all the particulars specified on that season ticket, or permit as the case may be, are clearly visible from outside the vehicle and from the front of the vehicle;
 - (d) the season ticket, or permit as the case may be, has not been withdrawn by the Council or altered or defaced.
- (14) In addition to the provisions of paragraphs (1) to (10) inclusive of this Article, a virtual type season ticket or virtual type permit shall only be valid if:-
- (a) the registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which that virtual type season ticket or virtual type permit has been granted is recorded on the parking permit electronic management system;
 - (b) the Council have granted that virtual type season ticket or virtual type permit for the leaving of the vehicle in the parking place in which it is left;
 - (c) that virtual permit has not been withdrawn or cancelled by the Council;
 - (d) the expiry date of that virtual type season ticket or virtual type permit, as indicated on the hand-held device, has not elapsed.

provided that it is reasonably necessary for the vehicle to be left in that parking place;

- (c) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying or repair of any main, pipe or apparatus within a parking place for the supply of gas, water, electricity, a sewer system or a telecommunication system, provided that it is reasonably necessary for the vehicle to be left in that parking place;
- (d) any vehicle left in a parking place for so long as is necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the enforcement of this Order or the removal of any vehicle from the parking place;
- (e) any vehicle left in a parking place with the written consent of the Council, provided that any conditions or requirements that the Council may impose are being complied with; or
- (f) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

PART V

OTHER CONDITIONS AND EXEMPTIONS

Removal of a vehicle from a parking place

29. Where a civil enforcement officer is of the opinion that any of the provisions of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in relation to a vehicle left in a parking place, they may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle and where it is so removed, the Council shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Closure of the parking place

30. (1) The Council may by notice or a sign displayed or by a barrier placed at the entrance or entrances to a parking place close that parking place or any part thereof or reserve for particular vehicles any parking bay or any other part of that parking place for any purpose.

(2) When a parking place is closed or a parking bay or other part of a parking place is reserved in accordance with paragraph (1) of this Article, no vehicle shall be left in the parking place, parking bay or other part of the parking place, as the case may be, unless the Council has authorised the vehicle to be left there.

Requirement to stop the engine of a vehicle

31. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in that parking place, and shall not start the engine except when changing the position of the vehicle within that parking place or departing from the parking place.

Use of a parking place in connection with the sale or offering for sale of goods

32. No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council, use a vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place.

Parked for a purpose other than that for which the parking place was designated

33. No person shall use any vehicle left in a parking place for the purpose of:-

- (a) sleeping, camping or cooking; or
- (b) servicing or washing that vehicle, other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.

Exemptions from certain provisions of this Order

34. Nothing in Article 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 of this Order shall apply in relation to: -

- (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
- (b) any vehicle being used in the service of the Council in pursuance of their statutory powers or other duties being carried out within the parking place,
