ORDER 2021 AMENDMENT ORDER No 3 2024**

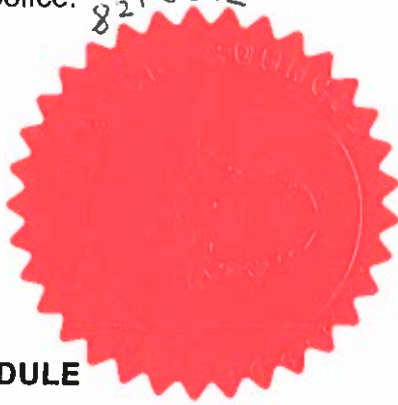
The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act propose make the following Order: *WAT*

The proposed Order will *come into operation on [30th September] 2024 and:*

1. Be cited as The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2021 Amendment Order No 3. 2024; and
2. will amend the Articles and Schedules of The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (as amended) as listed in the Schedule hereto.
3. Exemptions to all of Article 2 above will apply to any vehicle to be used for emergency purposes by the fire brigade, ambulance or police. *821 6692*

“(p) has left a Motor Vehicle parked in a car park when closed.”
