The Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes ("the Council") in exercise of the powers of the said Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), and (4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 hereby makes the following Order: -

PART 1

IMPLEMENTATION AND CITATION

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 5 September 2011 and may be cited as "The Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes (Various Roads within Milton Keynes and Surrounding Areas) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) Order 2008) Variation Order 2011".
- 2. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- 3. The plans annexed to this Order identify the lengths of roads subject to this Order, provided that where there is any inconsistency between the plans and the Articles it is the wording of the Articles which shall prevail.

PART 2

VARIATIONS

- 4. The Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes (Various Roads within Milton Keynes and Surrounding Areas) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) Order 2008" ("The Principal Order") is varied as provided by the following provisions of this Order:-

BEAUFORT DRIVE, WILLEN EAST SIDE




BRIDGE STREET, NEW BRADWELL SOUTH-WEST SIDE


NS117 From a point approximately 61 metres south-west of its junction with Church Street, for a distance of approximately 31.6 metres in a south-westerly and south-easterly direction.




NS118 From a point approximately 44 metres east of its junction with Clegg Square continuing for a distance of approximately 31.6 metres in an easterly direction




















HIGHLAND CLOSE, BLETCHLEY NORTH-WEST SIDE

WORDSWORTH DRIVE, BLETCHLEY EAST SIDE

NS123 From a point approximately 124.6 metres south of its junction with Buckingham Road continuing for a distance of approximately 25.6 metres in a north-easterly direction

NOONLAYER DRIVE, MIDDLETON EAST SIDE

NS124 From a point approximately 15 metres south of a point in line with the northern boundary wall of number 1 Digby Croft, continuing for a distance of approximately 43.5 metres in a northerly direction
