THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (1) and 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) and 32 35 and 36 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:- _____

Citation and commencement

1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Mole Valley) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and Free On-Street Parking Places) Order 2004) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2009" and shall come into operation on 12 January 2009 _____

Interpretation

2 (1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them - _____

"parking place" means any part of a road authorised by this Order to be used as a street parking place _____

"parking space" means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of vehicles _____

"street parking place" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act _____

"the Order of 2004" means The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Mole Valley) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and Free On-Street Parking Places) Order 2004 _____

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment _____

- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2004 shall have the same meaning as in that Order _____

Amendment of the Order of 2004

3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Order of 2004 shall have effect as though:- _____

- (a) in the ARRANGEMENT OF ARTICLES for the words "PART III - DESIGNATION OF FREE STREET PARKING PLACES" there were substituted the words "PART III - PARTS OF ROADS AUTHORISED TO BE USED AS FREE STREET PARKING PLACES" _____

- (d) in the ARRANGEMENT OF SCHEDULES in the item relating to the THIRD SCHEDULE in the first line thereof for the words "Designated parking places" there were substituted the words "Authorised parking places" _____

(i) for the words "telecommunication system" wherever those words occur there were substituted the words "electronic communication apparatus" _____

(j) for Article 3 there was substituted the following Article - _____

"3 SAVE as provided in Articles 4 5 6 7 and 8 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait - _____

(a) at any time in the lengths of roads specified and described in the First Part of the First Schedule _____

(b) between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of roads specified and described in the Second Part of the First Schedule _____

Authorisation of parking places and application of the Order of 2004 thereto

4 • (1) Each part of a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a road specified in the Second Column of the Second Schedule to this Order and unless otherwise so specified bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 1.83 metres is authorised to be used subject to the following provisions of this Order and of the provisions of the Order of 2004 specified in paragraph (2) of this Article as a parking place _____

(2) The provisions of the Order of 2004 (other than Articles 1 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 11 12 25 and 35) shall apply to the parts of the roads referred to in The Second Schedule to this Order and authorised to be used as parking places by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a _____

reference to the parts of the roads authorised to be used as a parking place by

this Order and referred to in the Third Schedule to this Order _____

5 THE Order of 2004 shall apply to the parking places to which are ascribed the numbers 5 6 7 and 8 set out in the First Column of The Second Schedule to this Order and which are authorised to be used as parking places by this Order as if the restricted hours (as defined in the Order of 2004) in relation to such parking places means the period between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive and the definition of "restricted hours" in the Order of 2004 in relation to those parking places shall have effect accordingly _____

Period for which a vehicle may be left in a parking place

6 WITHOUT prejudice to the provisions of Article 19 of the Order of 2004 or of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to be left in a parking place described in The Second Schedule to this Order during the restricted hours for a continuous period of more than four hours: _____

PROVIDED THAT nothing in this Article shall apply to a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority _____





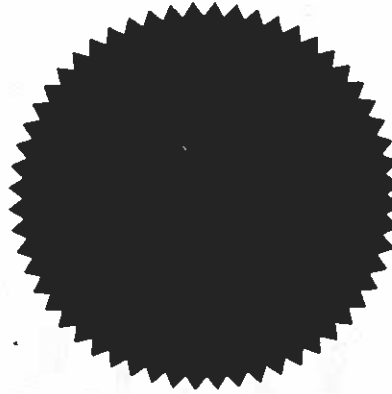
