WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(ACCESS ROAD INTO PENTWYN ESTATE, BAGLAN, PORT TALBOT) (REVOCATION) AND (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 1989

The Council of the County of West Glamorgan in exercise of its powers as contained in Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the IAH day of JUNE 1989 and may be cited as the West Glamorgan County Council (Access Road into Pentwyn Estate, Baglan, Port Talbot) (Revocation) and (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Unloading) Order 1989
- In this Order:-

"public service vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

"school bus" means a vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than eight passengers and being used to carry persons to and from school

"works bus" means a vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than eight passengers and being used to carry persons to and from school

"local service" has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Transport Act 1985.

- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. The provisions of the following Orders are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the sides or lengths of road as set out in the Schedules to this Order:-
 - (i) The Council of the Borough of Port Talbot (Access Road to Pentwyn Estate) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1972 made by the former Port Talbot Borough Council on 8 December 1972
 - (ii) Borough of Port Talbot (Baglan Road/Pentwyn Shopping Centre Layby) (Prohibition of Waiting Order 1973 made by the former Port Talbot Borough Council on 22nd November 1973

- (iv) West Glamorgan County Council (Baglan Road and Church Crescent, Baglan, Port Talbot) (Revocation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976 made by the West Glamorgan County Council on 3 December 1976.
- 5. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or to be loaded or unloaded at any time on the sides or lengths of road as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 6. Save as provided in Article 7 to this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or to be loaded or unloaded at any time on the sides or lengths of road as set out in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 7. Nothing in Article 6 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any public service vehicle operating a local service, a school bus or works bus to wait on the side or length of road referred to therein for so long as is necessary to enable passengers to board or alight from the said vehicles.
- 8. The provisions of this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction on the sides or lengths of road referred to herein whether imposed under the Act of 1984 or otherwise.

SCHEDULE ONE

Prohibition of Waiting, No Loading/Unloading At Any Time Order Access Road to Pentwyn Estate (Both Sides)

From the south side of Baglan Road to the north side of Furnley Drive.


SCHEDULE TWO

Prohibition of Waiting, No Loading/Unloading At Any Time, except for Service Buses Baglan Road (South Side in the Layby - Visibility Splay)

From the eastern kerb line of the Access Road for a distance of 43 metres in an easterly direction to the limit of the zig zag markings of the 'zebra' crossing.
