(ASH GROVE AND OAK GROVE, CIMLA, NEATH)

(ONE-WAY) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 1983

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Section 1 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84(C) (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the road or lengths of road specified in column A of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road or lengths of road in column B of the said Schedule.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the **Z8K** day of **November** 1983 and may be cited as the West Glamorgan County Council (Ash Grove and Oak Grove, Cimla, Neath) (One-Way) Experimental Order 1983.

SCHEDULE

COLUMN A

Ash Grove from its junction with Pine Grove to its junction with Oak Grove.

Oak Grove from its junction with Ash Grove to the roundabout at its junction with Pine Grove.

COLUMN B

From south west to north east

From north to south.
