

WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(BAGLAN ROAD AND OLD ROAD REAR LANES, BAGLAN, PORT TALBOT)

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) AND (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1980

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the rear lane connecting Old Road and Baglan Road other than in a northerly direction.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to be driven in the service lane adjacent to No. 61 Old Road, Baglan from its junction with Old Road for a distance of 28 metres (30 yards) in a westerly direction.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 7 day of July, 1980 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council" (Baglan Road and Old Road Rear Lanes, Baglan, Port Talbot) (Prohibition of Driving) and (One-Way Traffic) Order, 1980.
