(COMMERCIAL STREET, ABERGWYNFI)

(REVOCATION OF PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1987

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 22nd day of *JANUARY* 198~~7~~ and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Commercial Street, Abergwynfi) (Revocation of Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The provisions of the West Glamorgan County Council (Commercial Street, Abergwynfi) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977 made on 7 July 1977 are hereby revoked in so far as that Order relates to the sides or lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

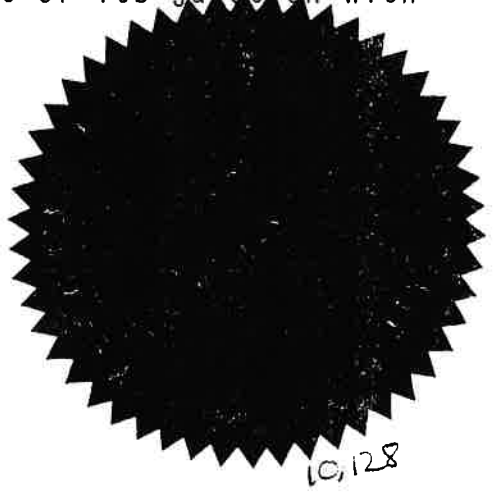
Revocation of Part of the West Glamorgan County Council (Commercial Street, Abergwynfi) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977.

Between points 20 metres and 50 metres west of its junction with the western kerbline of Station Road.
