ORDER 1994

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 4th day of March 1994 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Croft Road and Windsor Road, Neath) (Hackney Carriage Stands) and (Revocation) Order 1994.
- 2. In this Order:

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986.

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 as amended by The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991.

"parking disc" means a disc issued by a Local Authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (B.S. 4631 - 1970) coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, and

"relevant position" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 as amended by the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1991.

"taxi" means a hackney carriage or a private hire vehicle.

"hackney carriage" shall have the same meaning as in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

- 3. The provisions of the West Glamorgan County Council (The Neath Town Centre) (Traffic Management) Order 1988 are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the sides or lengths of roads referred to in the Schedule I to this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5 or 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of the Police Constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides or lengths of roads at any time as set out in Schedule 2 to this Order.

- 8. Save as provided in Articles 6 and 7 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait for longer than one hour, return prohibited within one hour to the same side or length of road between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day except Sunday on the sides or lengths of road as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- 9. In addition to the prohibitions imposed by Article 8 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle other than a licensed hackney carriage to wait between the hours of 8.00 p.m. and midnight and midnight to 3.00 a.m. on any day on the same sides or lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 10. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULES

Schedule I - Revocation

The West Glamorgan County Council (Neath Town Centre Traffic Management) Order 1988 insofar as it related to the lengths or sides of the following roads:

Croft Road

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

Between points approximately 35 metres and 65 metres north west of its junction with The Parade.

<u>Windsor Road</u>

Waiting Limited to 1 hour, Return Prohibited within 1 hour, 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday

Between points approximately 10 metres and 30 metres north of its junction with the Ropewalk (Ropewalk Terrace).

Schedule 2

Prohibition of waiting AT ANY TIME except for taxies between the hours of 8.00 p.m. and 3.00 a.m.

Croft Road (North East Side)

Between points approximately 35 metres and 65 metres north west of its junction with The Parade.

Schedule 3

Waiting limited to 1 hour, return prohibited within 1 hour 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday, taxies only between the hours of 8.00 p.m. and 3.00 a.m.

Windsor Road (West Side)

Between points approximately 10 metres and 30 metres north of its junction with The Ropewalk (Ropewalk Terrace).
