**(DAN Y GRAIG ROAD, MELYN, NEATH)
(REVOCATION OF RESIDENTS ONLY PARKING)**

ORDER 2014

The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the Act of 1984) and of all other powers then enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 30th day of June 2014 and may be cited as the “Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Dan y Graig Road, Melyn, Neath) (Revocation of Residents Only Parking) Order 2014”.
- 2.(1) Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The provisions contained in Articles 3 and 4 and Schedule 2 of the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Various Streets in Neath, Melyn, Briton Ferry and Port Talbot) (Residents Parking and Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time) Order 1997 are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the sides and lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Dan y Graig Road, Melyn, Neath – South Side

From a point 38m approximately south-east of the eastern kerbline of Cryddan Road for a distance of approximately 10m in a south-easterly direction.

Dan y Graig Road, Melyn, Neath – East Side

- A. From a point 100m (approximately) east of the eastern kerbline of Cryddan Road for a distance of approximately 18m in a north-easterly direction.
- B. From a point 148m (approximately) east of the eastern kerbline of Cryddan Road for a distance of approximately 18m in a north-easterly direction.
