# (EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME AND 24 HOUR CLEARWAY)

# (FFORDD AMAZON, JERSEY MARINE, NEATH) ORDER 2010

THE COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November 2010 and may be cited as the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Experimental Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time and 24 Hour Clearway) (Ffordd Amazon, Jersey Marine, Neath, Neath) Order 2010.
- 2. This Order is an experimental Order and shall have effect for a maximum duration of 18 months from the 29th day of November 2010.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. This Order may be modified or suspended by the Proper Officer of the Authority when it appears to him essential:-
  - (a) in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or:
  - (b) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs.
- 5. (1) In this Order -

"Disabled Persons Vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

"Disabled Persons Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

"Parking Disc" means a parking disc issued by a Local Authority, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;

"Relevant Position" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

- (F) The vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
- 9. Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of sides of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded and unloaded from the vehicle.
- 10. The prohibitions imposed by Article 7 of this Order shall not apply to Police, Fire, Ambulance or other Emergency Service vehicles or to Local Authority vehicles when in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.
- 11. Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the lengths of sides of roads referred to in the Article for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same length of side of road on which that vehicle had previously been waiting).

### **SCHEDULES**

### Schedule 1 – 24 Hour Clearway Order

# Ffordd Amazon, Jersey Marine (South Carriageway)

1.1 From its junction with Amazon roundabout for a distance of approximately 161 metres in a north westerly direction.

#### Ffordd Amazon, Jersey Marine (North Carriageway)

1.2 From its junction with Amazon roundabout for a distance of approximately 213 metres in a north westerly direction.

# Schedule 2 - Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

#### Ffordd Amazon, Jersey Marine (South Side)

From a point approximately 161 metres from its junction with Amazon roundabout for a distance of approximately 620 metres in a north westerly then westerly direction.

## Ffordd Amazon, Jersey Marine (North Side)

2.2 From a point approximately 213 metres from its junction with Amazon roundabout for a distance of approximately 570 metres in a north westerly then westerly direction.
