**(EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME AND
LIMITED WAITING)**

**(BRUNEL WAY AND ACCESS ROADS, BAGLAN ENERGY PARK, NEATH)
ORDER 2010**

THE COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April 2010 and may be cited as the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Experimental Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time and Limited Waiting) (Brunel Way and Access Roads, Baglan Energy Park, Neath) Order 2010.
2. This Order is an experimental Order and shall have effect for a maximum duration of 18 months from the 1st day of April 2010.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order may be modified or suspended by the Proper Officer of the Authority when it appears to him essential:-
 - (a) in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or;
 - (b) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs.
5. (1) In this Order -

“Disabled Persons Vehicle” has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

“Disabled Persons Badge” has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

“Parking Disc” means a parking disc issued by a Local Authority, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;

“Relevant Position” has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

“Public Services Vehicle” shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 and “local service” shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Universal Service Providers” means those operators of postal services who are licensed to provide all or part of a Universal Postal Service under the provisions contained in the Postal Service Act 2000.

- (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
6. Save as provided in Articles 8, 9, 10 and 11 of this Order no person except at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of sides of road as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order.
7. Save as provided in Articles 8, 9, 10 and 12 of this Order no person except at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait for more than 2 hours or to return within 4 hours to the same length of side of road on which that period of waiting began on any day except Saturday and Sunday between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on the length of side of road set out in Schedule 2 of this Order.
8. Nothing in Articles 6 and 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicles to wait on the lengths of sides of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable: -
- (A) A person to board or alight from a vehicle;
- (B) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely: -
- (i) Building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (ii) The removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) The laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of sides of road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (C) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority or a Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (D) The vehicle to be used by a Universal Service Provider for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;

- (E) Public Service Vehicles operating a local service when waiting at an authorised bus stop to set down or pick up passengers, or to school buses;
 - (F) The vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
9. Nothing in Articles 6 and 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of sides of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded and unloaded from the vehicle.
10. The prohibitions imposed by Articles 6 and 7 of this Order shall not apply to Police, Fire, Ambulance or other Emergency Service vehicles or to Local Authority vehicles when in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.
11. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the lengths of sides of roads referred to in the Article for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same length of side of road on which that vehicle had previously been waiting).
12. Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait on the length of side of road referred to in the said Article.

SCHEDULES

Schedule 1 – Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

Motor Auctions Access Road, Baglan Energy Park (Both Sides)

- ✓ 1.1 From its junction with Brunel Way for a distance of approximately 18 metres in a southerly direction.

Access Road 1, Baglan Energy Park (Both Sides)

- ✓ 1.2 From its junction with Brunel Way for a distance of approximately 240 metres in a north easterly direction.

The Quays Access Road, Baglan Energy Park (Both Sides)

- ✓ 1.3 From its junction with Brunel Way for a distance of approximately 88 metres in a westerly then southerly direction.

SRC Access Road, Baglan Energy Park (Both Sides)

- ✓ 1.4 From its junction with Brunel Way for a distance of approximately 233 metres in a westerly direction.

✓ **Access Road 2, Baglan Energy Park (Both Sides)**

- 1.5 From its junction with Brunel Way for a distance of approximately 324 metres in a north easterly direction.

✓ **Access Road 3, Baglan Energy Park (Both Sides)**

- 1.6 From its junction with Access Road 2 for a distance of approximately 188 metres in a southerly direction.

✓ **Access Road 4, Baglan Energy Park (Both Sides)**

- 1.7 From a point approximately 21 metres west of the western kerbline of its junction with Access Road 3 for a distance of approximately 188 metres in an easterly direction.

✓ **Brunel Way, Baglan Energy Park (South Side)**

- 1.8 From its junction with the A48 for a distance of approximately 457 metres in a south westerly direction.

✓ **Brunel Way, Baglan Energy Park (East Side)**

- 1.9 Between points approximately 8 metres and 192 metres and approximately 242 metres and 415 metres from a point opposite the southern kerbline of The Quays Access Road in a southerly direction.

✓ **Brunel Way, Baglan Energy Park (North West Side)**

- 1.10 From its junction with the A48 for a distance of approximately 636 metres in a south westerly direction.

✓ **Brunel Way, Baglan Energy Park (West Side)**

- 1.11 From a point approximately 184 metres south of the southern kerbline of The Quays Access Road for a distance of approximately 200 metres in a southerly direction.

Schedule 2 – Limited Waiting Monday – Friday 8.00am – 6.00pm 2 Hours No Return Within 4 Hours

✓ **Brunel Way, Baglan Energy Park (East Side)**

- 2.1 Between points approximately 22 metres and 73 metres and approximately 257 metres and 315 metres from a point opposite the northern kerbline of the SRC Access Road in a northerly direction.
