(PONTARDAWE REGENERATION SCHEME)

ORDER 2012

The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of February 2012 and may be cited as the "Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Herbert Street and Holly Street, Pontardawe) (Pontardawe Regeneration Scheme) Order 2012".
2. (1) In this Order –
 - "Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000;
 - "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) (Amended) Regulations 2000;
 - "Parking Disc" means a parking disc issued by a Local Authority, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;
 - "Relevant Position" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) (Amended) Regulations 2000;
 - "Universal Service Providers" means those operators of postal services who are licensed to provide all or part of a Universal Postal Service under the provisions contained in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - "Loading Bay" means a parking place designated by this Order as a parking place only for the use of goods vehicles which are loading or unloading goods;
 - "Disabled Parking Bay" means an area of highway designated as a parking place for use by Disabled Badge holders only;

“Mechanical Cleansing Vehicle” shall mean a street/drain cleaning vehicle owned by or contracted to the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council.

- (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The provisions of all existing Road Traffic Regulation Orders are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the lengths of sides of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
4. Save as provided in Articles 5, 6 and 7 of this Order, no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on the lengths of sides of roads set out in Schedule 2 of this Order.
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of sides of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
 - (A) A person to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (B) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of sides of road or any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (C) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority or a Water Authority when in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (D) The vehicle to be used by a Universal Service Provider for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets.
6. The prohibitions imposed by Article 4 of this Order shall not apply to Police, Fire, Ambulance or other Emergency Service vehicles or to Local Authority vehicles when in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.

7. The prohibitions imposed by Article 4 shall not apply to goods vehicles using the specifically signed Loading Bays or Disabled Badge holder's using the designated Disabled Parking Bays.
8. Save as provided in Articles 5, 6 and 16 of this Order or upon the direction or permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to park in the Disabled Parking Bay set out in Schedule 3 of this Order between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on Mondays to Saturdays unless that vehicle is a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Persons Badge.
9. Save as provided in Articles 5, 6 and 10 of this Order no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle (including a Disabled Person's Vehicle) to wait, load or unload between the hours of 8.00am and 10.00am on any day except Sunday in the Loading Bay set out in Schedule 4 of this Order.
10. The provisions of Article 9 of this Order shall not apply to Goods Vehicles which are being loaded or unloaded.
11. Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the length of road set out in Schedule 5 of this Order other than in the direction specified therein.
12. Nothing in Article 11 of this Order shall apply to a Mechanical Cleansing Vehicle whilst engaged in any street/drain cleaning operations on behalf of the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council.
13. Save as provided in Articles 5, 6, 15 and 16 of this Order, no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait for more than 1 hour or to return within 2 hours to the same length of side of road on which that period of waiting began on any day except Sunday between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on the lengths of sides of road set out in Schedule 6 of this Order.
14. Save as provided in Articles 5, 6, 15 and 16 of this Order, no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait for more than 1 hour or to return within 2 hours to the same length of side of road on which that period of waiting began on any day except Sunday between the hours of 10.00am to 6.00pm on the lengths of sides of road set out in Schedule 7 of this Order.
15. Nothing in Articles 13 and 14 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge to wait on the lengths of sides of roads referred to in the said Article.

16. Nothing in Articles 13 And 14 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of sides of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle.

SCHEDULES

Schedule 1 – Revocations

1.1 **Herbert Street, Pontardawe**

From a point approximately 173 metres east of its junction with A474 Swansea Road for a distance of approximately 84 metres in a south westerly direction.

1.2 **Holly Street, Pontardawe**

From its junction with Herbert Street for a distance of approximately 24 metres in a north easterly direction.

Schedule 2 - Restricted Zone, No Waiting, Loading or Unloading At Any Time Except in Signed Bays

2.1 **Herbert Street, Pontardawe**

From a point approximately 173 metres east of its junction with A474 Swansea Road for a distance of approximately 84 metres in a south easterly direction.

2.2 **Holly Street, Pontardawe**

From its junction with Herbert Street for a distance of approximately 24 metres in a north easterly direction.

Schedule 3 – Disabled Bay Blue Badge Holders Only, Monday – Saturday, 8.00am to 6.00pm

3.1 **Herbert Street, Pontardawe (North East Side)**

From a point approximately 40 metres south east of its junction with Holly Street for a distance of approximately 19 metres in a south easterly direction.

Schedule 4 – Goods Vehicles Loading Only, Monday – Saturday, 8.00am to 10.00am

4.1 **Herbert Street, Pontardawe (South West Side)**

From a point approximately 21 metres south east of its junction with Holly Street for a distance of approximately 23 metres in a south easterly direction.

Schedule 5 – One Way Traffic

5.1 **Herbert Street, Pontardawe**

From its junction with Holly Street in a south easterly then north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 264 metres.

Schedule 6 – Waiting Limited to 1 Hour, Return Prohibited Within 2 Hours,
8.00am to 6.00pm, Monday – Saturday

6.1 **Herbert Street, Pontardawe (South West Side)**

From a point approximately 46 metres south west of its junction with Holly Street for a distance of approximately 12 metres in a south easterly direction.

Schedule 7 – Waiting Limited to 1 Hour, Return Prohibited Within 2 Hours,
10.00am to 6.00pm, Monday – Saturday

7.1 **Herbert Street, Pontardawe (South West Side)**

From a point approximately 21 metres south west of its junction with Holly Street for a distance of approximately 24 metres in a south easterly direction.
