

WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL
(HERBERT STREET BY PASS) (PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS)
ORDER 1982) (VARIATION) ORDER 1988

The West Glamorgan County Council in pursuance of its powers as contained in Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the West Glamorgan County Council (Herbert Street By Pass) (Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 1982) (Variation) Order 198 and shall come into operation on the 30th day of June 1988.
2. The provisions of the West Glamorgan County Council (Herbert Street By Pass) (Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 1986 made by the West Glamorgan County Council on 19th April 1982 are hereby varied by the revocation of the provisions of that Order in so far as they refer or relate to the side or length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as they apply for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE

Herbert Street By Pass (south side).

From a point 20 metres west of the western kerbline of Ynysderw Road westwards a distance of approximately 85 metres.
